Dear First Lutheran Church FAMILY:

As August is wrapping up and we are looking ahead to September the questions before us are:

- Where did the summer go?
- Now what? What is on the schedule and what is happening at First Lutheran?

I am excited to say there is much to call us back together as the family of God. Family is the first word that comes to mind as we turn the calendar to September. That will be our theme in worship starting on September 9th. What does family mean? What does it mean that we are part of God's family? What does it mean to be part of the family at First Lutheran? The lessons and sermons will focus on that theme for September 9th, 16th, and 23rd, and the 30th. Come and learn about families from the Bible and what we can learn about life and our how can our family life be healthy.

RALLY SUNDAY is always a day of celebration, new beginnings and the Church family. **Rally Sunday is September 9th at 9:30.** Our theme this year is “**Generation to Generation.**” During worship we will hear from persons of different generations and what school and Sunday School was like in their generation. Other activities on Rally Sunday include:

- Blessing of backpacks. Kids youth and adults bring your backpack and we will have a special prayer for your year ahead at school and work. We will also be blessing the school kits that women have assembled for Lutheran World Relief.
- We will be presenting three year old Bibles and third grade Bibles.
- We will hear from the youth who went to the National Youth Gathering.
- There will be dinner following worship.

Come and join all these festivities.

On **Wednesday, September 12th at 5:45** we will be having a gathering of parents of young children for a time of getting to know one another, sharing a resource on parenting, and building one another up. Snacks and childcare will be provided. This is a time for YOU as parents to come and be renewed and connect with others.

Confirmation for 6th- 8th graders will begin on **Wednesday, September 12th at 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.** We will be studying Martin Luther’s Small Catechism this fall as well as Scripture passages that deal with those themes.

Sunday School will be meeting starting **September 16th at 9:45.** Following the children’s sermon, the SS children, ages 3-5th grades, will be dismissed to go downstairs for singing and storytime.

Adults - you are asked to rally at the parsonage on **Tuesday, September 25th at 6:30** for a time of prayer and fellowship. We want to have this be a time of praying for one another, our congregation, and nation. This is also a time of discussion on prayer and fellowship. If you cannot come right at 6:30 join us when you can. We will conclude by 8:00. The parsonage is located at 843 6th St. SW.


As you can see September is a time to rally, to come together as God’s family and celebrate all that we have been given. Indeed God is faithful from generations to generations here at First Lutheran.

1st Lutheran Church Council Meeting Minutes Aug 8th, 2018

Members Present: Pastor Joyce, Bob Douty, Paul Henriksen, Nancy Johnson, Teresa Jansen, Gen Velde, Neil Johnson, and Deb Reinert.

Members Absent: Mark Zinnel, Kristen Brockberg.

Call to Order: President Douty called the meeting to order at 8:00 pm.

Devotions: Neil Johnson

REPORTS:

Secretary's Report:

All members present reviewed the minutes from the July 11th, 2018 meeting. A motion was made and seconded to approve. Motion passed.

Treasurers Report:

Bob Douty reviewed the financial reports to include the payables with the members present. Discussion followed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the report as written. Motion carried.

Pastors Report:

- Four (4) individuals from South Africa met with Pastor Joyce and Gen Velde and they toured the monument, the meat locker and had lunch at Lange's Café. Very interesting exchange of ideas and cultures.
- Numerous weddings and funerals took place from last month.
- During July Paul Henriksen and the Pastor met with 5 family members to discuss membership at First Lutheran Church. On 8 Aug at SW park this discussion will continue.
- Confirmation will be starting in September
- Met with Confirmation Youth about completing requirements
- ALICE Training was conducted for about 30 individuals regarding an active shooter scenario.
- Pastor will be involved at a retreat at Lake Shetek during the period 24-25 Aug.
- Pastor will be out of the office August 27 – Sept 3.

President Report:

The President informed the Council that Monica Derby has submitted her resignation as Council Secretary due to her work and family schedule.

Adult Ed Report:

Parenting w/Hope for young families is a program being started shortly. A letter explaining and introducing the book will be sent out within the next few weeks. Meeting will be conducted on the 12th of Sept. at 5:45 pm.

Congregational Life:

Committee is working on Rally Sunday.

Outreach and Mission:

Noisy offering to be continued every Sunday using the funds towards the upcoming Banquet on Oct 24th.

Breakdown by Quarter is:

- 2nd Qtr raised over \$1018.00 given to the food shelf.
- 3rd Qtr goal is to collect coats and hats up to the date of the Banquet.
- 4th Qtr looking at the Heifer Project.

Property Management:

- Shingle report. Neil has met with Jerry Brockberg regarding the reimbursement of the additional cost over and above the dollars that we had received to date. Jerry indicated that Grinnell Insurance Co will cut a check to 1st Lutheran for the additional expense of approx. \$9,100.00. Very good news.
- August 25th is a date the committee has decided to schedule for outside fall clean-up.
- Committee is getting a bid for outside spraying and fertilizing.
- Parsonage garage door rubber stripping needs replacement.
- Committee is looking at replacing the deck at the parsonage with possible cement. The deck is in bad shape.

Sunday School: No Report

Worship:

- Rally Sunday-9 Sep (Generation to Generation Theme)
- Looking for music at the worship service for Aug 19th as no organist available.

Youth:

Fair Stand Report - Went OK, some of the shifts were short of workers that made it hard to operate. Will get a financial report to us after all the expenses have been submitted. Looking at different options for workers next year. Thanks to all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Constitution and By-laws: Schedule of time line will be submitted by the President for council to review by next meeting - 90 days prior.

Job Descriptions: Continuing to be updated by all committees.

Pre-School: Contract (Lease) has been reviewed by Barduson Law Office. They made changes that were sent back for our approval. Final copy was received and has been forwarded to Pipestone Area Schools for their signature.

Personnel Committee: Lay personnel have been identified by the church staff to be a part of the Personnel Committee. Two are needed. The staff will contact them.

NEW BUSINESS:

A replacement for the council secretary is needed. However it was first decided to contact Monica (Deb Reinhart will call) to seek her continued service as the secretary before we canvass others as a replacement.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

ADJOURNMENT. The meeting was adjourned by President Douty at 9:45 pm.



Pre-School (1st Lutheran Church) School Year 2018-2019

Over the last few months your church council and the Pipestone Area School have met on numerous occasions to discuss the possibility of leasing some of the downstairs classrooms to the Pipestone Area Pre-School for the upcoming school year. The intent of the school was to consolidate locations (from the previous location of United Methodist and Jasper) to make the Pre-School more economical for transportation, feeding etc.

Our church was a good fit for the number of rooms they needed and the availability of those rooms were not being used on a regular basis. We have done our due diligence on our part of establishing a solid lease that provides good guidance for both the lessor and lessee. We are still crossing the t's and dotting the i's and I'm sure there will be some questions on both parties as we move forward through the school year. Toni Baartman has been instrumental in the coordination and I thank her for her input, guidance and understanding.

Mark Zinnel our Youth & Family Ministry Coordinator and Custodian will oversee the day to day coordination with the school. If there are any questions, feel free to address them to him or any member of the church council.



2018 Fair stand "Thank you"






Senior & Junior High September Youth Activity


