

Leave the old behind and come be with me." Matthew, the tax collector, sitting behind a tax collector desk and then Jesus comes and says, "Follow me." The men and women who followed Jesus gave up life as they knew it. Their journey took them to meals with other people. They observed Jesus healing and teaching others.
