

- MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: Cristy Appel, Robert Baerenwald, Danielle Ossefoort, Sarah Meyer, Pastor Ann Zastrow, Nicole Weber, Marit Sterud, Al Hollingsworth ABSENT: Kristy Henriksen, Karen Boehm, Thad Reinert
- TREASURER'S REPORT: Table payment to SW MN Synod of \$800, will do some brain-storming on how to cuts some costs to help with heating/cooling expenses
 - PASTOR'S REPORT: We have two 9th grade confirmation students who will be confirmed.
 Church employee health insurance policies were reviewed and selected.
 - Unfinished Business notes: Youth Committee gave the church \$6500 from the FLY Fairstand proceeds; Coffee maker is up and running; Planned Giving is January 11th, 2026; Holy Buzz will be the 2nd Sunday of every month.
- New Business: Each committee will submit their budgets for 2026 to Kristy H by November 1st
- Congregational Life: Football at the Three Maidens on October 3rd had 20 people in attendance!
- Property Management: Bell tower inspection was done and many issues were found by Walker Brothers Roofing from Sloan, IA. Repair and replacement quote as \$23,995. This is for the EX-TERIOR ONLY. The cost may increase based on what they find once the exterior is removed. An energy audit has also been requested for the church.
 - LIFT & Youth: We have 50 kids in LIFT! We had 24 kids plus chaperones who attended the Cade Thompson concert in Luverne. The kids LOVED it!! Looking in to possible Stampede or SkyForce games for winter activities.
- Worship: First Contemporary service was held on Wednesday, Oct. 8th. Sixty kids and adults were in attendance.
- Serve at the Banquet Wednesday, November 5th. We will need 5-6 people to help with meal prep during the day shift.
 - Personnel Committee met for a closed door session.






