



Epiphany is the day the Wise Men / Magi brought gifts to the Christ child – the first Christmas gifts! In the Middle Ages, there were only religious holidays, so people tried to make them last as long as possible. In wealthy households, a gift was often given each of the 12 days. The carol of “The 12 Days of Christmas” probably comes from the 1500s, when “counting” songs were popular.

A partridge in a pear tree  
Two turtle doves  
Three French hens  
Four calling birds  
Five golden rings  
Six geese a-laying

Seven swans a-swimming  
Eight maids a-milking  
Nine ladies dancing  
Ten lords a-leaping  
Eleven pipers piping  
Twelve drummers drumming

In 2025, buying the gift of the day each of the 12 days would cost \$51,476.12, up 4.5% over 2024. If the gifts accumulated to bring the total to 364 gifts (12 partridges in pear trees, 22 turtle doves, 30 French hens, etc), it would cost \$218,542.98, up 4.4% over 2024. (according to the PNC Christmas Price Index, <https://www.pnc.com/en/about-pnc/topics/pnc-christmas-price-index.html#gifts>).

Don't rush Christmas to be over December 26th! Enjoy the delight of the season, eating cookies, drinking hot chocolate or warm apple cider, spending time with family and friends, amid the twinkle of lights and the glow of candles. Spend some time pondering the mystery of Christ's birth, his ministry, his death, and his resurrection. Especially as school children have 2 full weeks of vacation this year, make the most of the precious time with family.

After the Season of Christmas comes the Season of Epiphany. Epiphany lasts from January 6 through Mardi Gras, or Fat Tuesday, which this year is February 17. Ash Wednesday is February 18, which is the start of Lent. During Epiphany, we look at the start of Jesus's ministry, the calling of the disciples, and the Sermon on the Mount.




## New Year, New Goals, New Challenges, Renewed Faith in Yourself

## Council Highlights from December 12th, 2025

- ◆ **MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:** Pastor Ann Zastrow, Kristy Henriksen, Sarah Meyer, Thad Reinert, Robert Baerenwald, Nicole Weber, Al Hollingsworth, Danielle Ossefoort, Cristy Appel & Marit Sterud  
Absent: Karen Boehm
- ◆ **TREASURER'S REPORT:** motion to pay Progress out of the Building Fund, table the cumulative payment to the SW Synod. All other bills to be paid as listed. Discussion on the depleted general fund - money from Youth and LIFT accounts were given to the general fund to help cover costs.
- ◆ **PASTOR'S REPORT:** requested to take Dec. 25 to the 29th off for vacation to be with family. The yearly housing allowance of \$1000 was also approved.
- ◆ **PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** will try to notate line items on the 2026 budget that are NOT paid by parishioners but from the endowment or other funds.
- ◆ **Unfinished Business notes:** Planned giving is January 11th, 2025, more information will be posted later. Lefse making went well with many attending. Nominating committee for committee spots has many spots to fill for 2026.
- ◆ **New Business:** Annual meeting is set for Jan. 25, 2026 following worship, reports are due to Lori by Dec. 15th. 2026 Council orientation will be on Feb. 1st, 2026 following worship.
- ◆ **Congregational Life:** searching for committee replacements. Upcoming Stampede hockey game with Youth leading the activity.
- ◆ **Property Management:** discussed the possibility of brick and masonry issues causing the leaking issues and not the actual roof. Will get a masonry consult before the roof repair. Energy audit was done - waiting on final report. Snowblower is not running consistently, will do a further assessment. Spring of 2026 will need a replacement of missing shingles.
- ◆ **LIFT & Youth:** Nights with LIFT & the contemporary service are being addressed. Many kids are being dropped off and unattended by parents during the service. Toys were purchased for the toy drive and given to Kiwanis for distribution. Stampede game in the works.
  - ◆ **Adult Education:** Continuation of current video series.
- ◆ **Future Business:** Cost-saving suggestions after energy audit & updates on drinking fountains



- 2) To the right (>) is a Quick Response (QR) code. When you scan the QR code image with a smartphone's QR decoder, it will instantly connect you to the mobile version of the church's Vanco/Simply Giving offering site. Just follow the directions on your screen.
- 3) Be watching for other options as they become available.
- 4) Good ol' offering envelopes - they are tried and true still today!!




