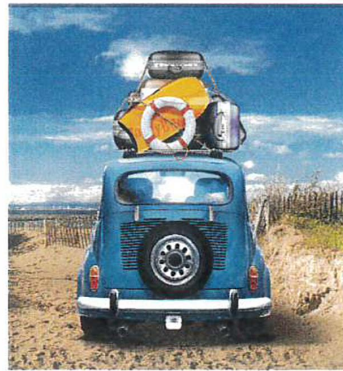
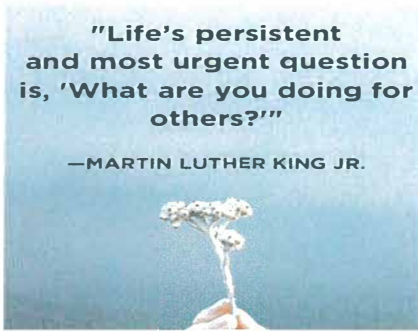

- 3) Be watching of some other options as they become available.
- 4) Good ol' offering envelopes.

- ◆ Missing shingles on the Fellowship Hall roof were fixed/replaced. Waiting on a bid for the repair of the bell tower. A 5-foot pad will be added to the Fairstand. Most of the supplies & labor needed for this project will be donated by members.
- ◆ Another grill was donated for our fairstand. The signup for the fairstand is in the works so we can get people signed up earlier this year. Ride tickets, meal tickets and cones will be given out again this year as well.

It seems like summer just started but before we know it, it will be FAIR TIME in Pipestone!!!

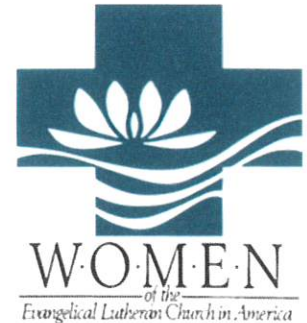
Our fairstand has been one of the main 'eateries' during the fair so we need everyones help! Sign-up for the fairstand should be out NO LATER
