OCTOBER: Month of Change/Reformation



October is upon us! October is a month of change – leaves turn color and fall off trees; the land becomes "flat" again, as crops are harvested, and the view is not blocked by corn or bean fields; days become cooler, and sweaters and hoodies are more appropriate (for older folks) than shorts and flip-flops (which

younger folks tend to wear longer). And in October, the lessons on Sundays are parables and stories which Jesus tells during Holy Week, final messages he has for his followers, and lessons for the Pharisees and others who were challenged by what he said.

At the end of October, we celebrate Reformation, where we remember Martin Luther, and how he thought he could change the Catholic church. Instead, his followers ended up breaking away from the Catholic church, and eventually called themselves "Lutherans," which Luther did not appreciate. There are no 9th grade students this year, so we will not celebrate confirmation on Reformation.

October also marks the beginning of my second year as your pastor. How has the time gone so quickly? I am still learning things, but my feet are a bit more under me, and things are starting to sound a bit familiar — I remember X (vaguely) from last year! I am glad to be here with you, and hope there will be many more years of partnership with you.




