- 2) To the right is a Quick Response (QR) code. When you scan the QR code image with a smartphone's QR decoder, it will instantly connect you to the mobile version of the church's Vanco/Simply Giving offering site. Just follow the directions on your screen.

- 3) Be watching of some other options as they become available.
- 4) Good ol' offering envelopes.

- We are still waiting on the ERC (CoVid Relief) check. This is a government check for about \$11,000 that we qualified for in August of last year.
- Money that is 'designated' for the building fund can be used as needed for building upkeep expenses.
- Pastor Ann will be gone on vacation July 13th—20th. Worship Team & Mark Carlson will lead the service on July 14th (with communion being moved to July 21st). Pastor will also have Continuing Ed August 6-9th in Sioux Falls and Zoom meetings on August 13th, 20th & 27th from 10am—1pm.
 - Congregational Life planning a campfire & s'more night at the Three Maidens.
 - We have not yet received a bid from Tinklenberg Construction for the bell tower repair.
 - A Venmo account will be setup to have available for the fairstand, Meatball Supper, offering, etc.
 - Giving statements for the first part of 2024 will be sent out by August 1st.
- Free meal, pie and ice cream cone tickets for members for the fair can be picked up as well as free ride tickets.
 - Extra concrete was poured at the fairstand.






BIBLE STUDY Bad Girls of the Bible, part 2

The power of prayer is strong, and we can all use prayer in our lives, especially our young people, as they make their way in the world.


