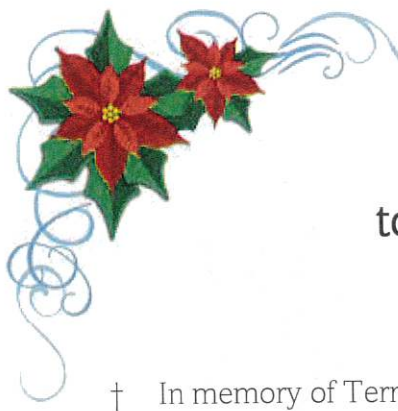
Blessing
