I do hope that if you haven't been able to attend worship here in person that either you are able to catch First Lutheran's worship service online, on the radio, or on tv, or that you have attended worship wherever you are.



It has been an eventful summer so far! We have had 6 children go to camp at Shetek, and one of our youth members was a counselor there. Some days were hot, other days were nice, some weather was rainy, but all report having had a good time. The weather was decent {but warm} for the Water Tower Festival at the end of June, and we had fantastic cooler, non-rainy (mostly) weather for the County Fair at the end of July/start of August. The only challenge for the fair was the air quality wasn't the greatest, but that didn't seem to bother much of anyone. We sold out of several menu items, even after buying more food!

We are in August Planning Mode, getting ready for the next program season. I am planning confirmation curriculum.

Confirmation orientation will be on Wednesday, September 3 (yes, the day after school starts) at 6:15 (our usual meeting time), for students and parents in grades 6, 7, and 8. I will meet with the 9th graders separately. The LIFT leaders are also looking at calendars and events for their students. Keep an eye on the LIFT and church Facebook pages for more information!

We are also planning an outdoor worship service on Sunday, September 7th, across the street at Southwest Park, at the usual 9:30 time. We will have Blessing of the Backpacks that day, as we kick off the fall season. I have enjoyed catching up with folks who have been in worship this summer, and I look forward to hearing about the summer adventures of others when you return in the fall. - 3) Be watching for other options as they become available.
- 4) Good ol' offering envelopes - they are tried and true still today!!

- ♦ TREASURER'S REPORT: Table the following bills: \$1000 (Synod), \$70.95 (Cristy Appel) & \$270.00 (Paul H.) until next month. Transfer funds (\$13500) from Reserve to cover the deficit. Bills for mowing should come out of the 'building fund' money.
- ♦ VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Met w/Karen Hellie regarding the Food Shelf. Sarah will be taking over the Food Shelf. FLC has signed up to work July 17<sup>th</sup> from 1:30pm-5pm. Will need 6-8 people to help so will make calls to people.
- ♦ PASTOR'S REPORT: Continuing Ed – participating in The Moses Project through Grand View University in Des Moines, IA. It will meet in person, August 2025, January 2026 & May 2026. The cost is \$250 plus mileage. The rest is covered by a Lilly Grant.
  - ♦ Congregational Life: Talking about the possibility of an outdoor morning service.
  - ♦ Property Management: Parsonage updates discussed – sealing the unused stack from the old water heater that was dripping into the main floor bathroom. Bell tower – have another person coming to look at it. Cost will be about \$1500.
  - ♦ Youth: Used all 50 tickets that were purchased for the Canaries game in Sioux Falls!
- ♦ New coffee maker has been delivered and is paid for. Will call the electrician to do the electrical cord. Will need a water filter for the coffee maker and water fountains.
  - ♦ WaterTower Festival - will not be participating this year
  - ♦ Still working on water fountains

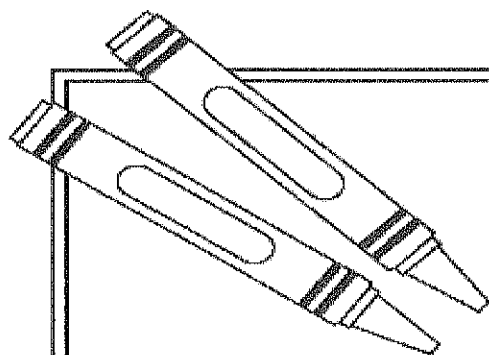

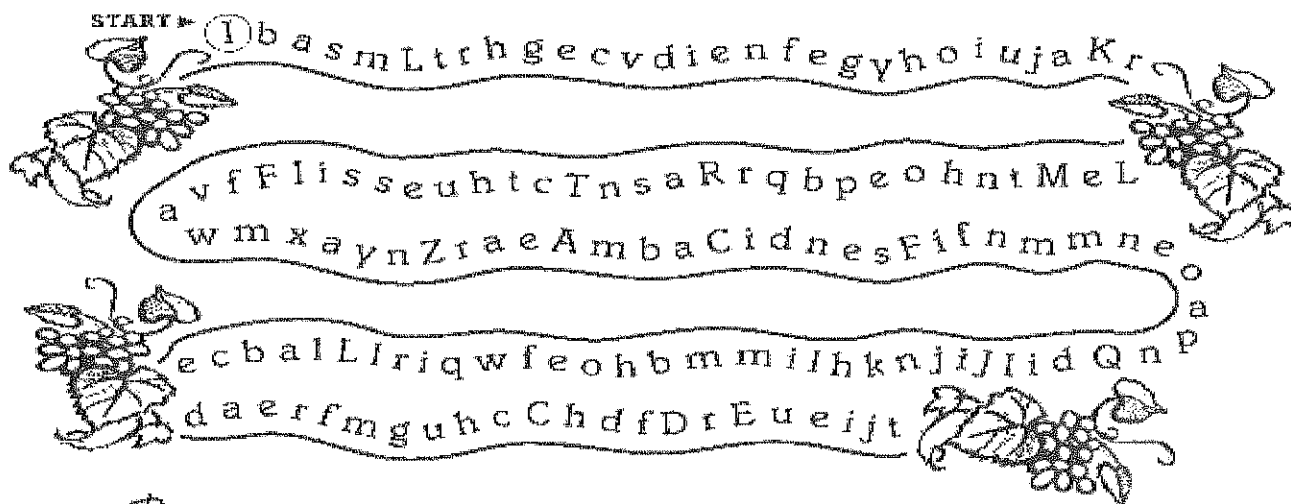

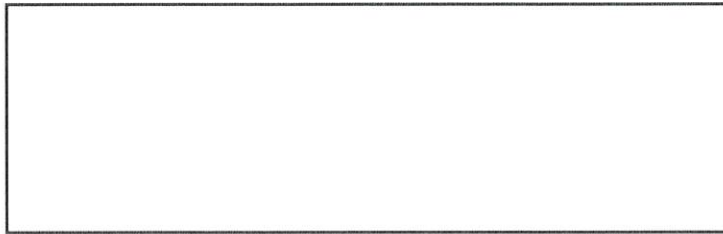
