Waiting on the Next Mountain Top Experience

We all love the mountaintop experiences of faith—those moments when God feels undeniably close, prayers are answered instantly, and our path seems crystal clear. These spiritual highs are invigorating; they provide us with a panoramic view of God's goodness and fill our lungs with the fresh air of hope. Naturally, we want to stay there. We want to set up camp and live in that state of elevation forever. However, the reality of our spiritual journey is that we cannot always live on the peak. Between every mountain range lies a valley, and often, that is where we find ourselves waiting.

It is easy to become discouraged when the excitement fades and the routine of daily life sets in. We might feel like we are just biding our time, anxiously scanning the horizon for the next big spiritual breakthrough. But God does not intend for the time between mountains to be wasted time. The valley is not just a path to get through; it is fertile ground for growth. In the quiet lulls, when the adrenaline of the mountaintop has worn off, our roots are forced to go deeper. We learn to trust God not because of what we feel, but because of who He is.

Waiting is an active stance of the heart, not a passive idling of the soul. As Isaiah reminds us, those who wait upon the Lord are actually renewing their strength. It is in the day-to-day faithfulness—the reading of the Word when we don't feel like it, the prayers whispered in the mundane moments—that spiritual muscle is built. God is just as present in the lowlands as He is on the

- ◆ **TREASURER'S REPORT:** Motion made to pay Progress & Pye Barker out of the Building Fund. Remainder of bills to be paid thru the General Fund. Motion made and passed. A quarterly summary was completed and will be available for those who would like to see it. Motion to pay pulpit supply plus mileage until a new pastor is acquired. Motion passed.
- ◆ **PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** Pastor Heather from the Synod will lead worship on May 17th and would like to meet with Council following the service to review the call process. Property management will do an inspection prior to and after Pastor has moved out of the parsonage.
- ◆ **VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** Discussion on how members needing visits will work. Contact Lori and we will get the process started with the appropriate people.
- ◆ **Congregational Life:** Canaries baseball game on Wednesday, June 17th for Faith and Family Night - tickets will be available to members soon!
- ◆ **Worship:** Lists of pastors from SD and MN Synods was collected. Calls are being made to fill in as many dates as possible. Several from the local area. Must have an ordained pastor for baptisms & communion. Communion will be once a month.
- ◆ **Property Management:** Walker Bros will begin work on the bell tower later this month. Kitchen floor grout will be cleaned and lights are getting updated. AC units need cleaning. Basement fire escape in Youth room will get fixed also.
- ◆ **Adult Education:** Robert attended Gustavus Adolphus for a one-day conference on April 18th. He will also start looking in to a new summer adult-ed series.
- ◆ **NEW Business:** More outlets needed in the fairstand; Motion made to take the rent/utilities that Ann would need to pay for the parsonage from 5/25 to 6/30 would come from the original \$2000 the church was giving her for a housing allowance. The church would then pay her the \$500 difference at the end of the rental period pending inspection; Prayer Partners/Prayer Chain - will be restarted by Sarah.
