Welcome to the End of the Year...already?!

The end of the year, you may ask, but it's not

December! This is true, but December is not the only time a year ends. Fiscal years often end June 30th. Everyone's year ends on the day before their birthday. Anniversaries also mark the end of one year, and the beginning of the next. In the church, the year ends the Sunday before Advent begins, which means this year, "New Year's Eve" is on November 24th, and "New Year's Day" is on December 1st, the First Sunday of Advent.

What do we do to prepare for a new year? Sometimes we clean the house, to start out fresh. Sometimes we bake special cakes, pies, or other treats. Sometimes we throw a party. In the church, the "New Year's Eve" Sunday is called Christ the King Sunday, where we recognize that Jesus IS indeed the King! When Jesus was doing his earthly ministry, his kingship was usually hidden, disguised in the things he taught and the miracles he did. He did not have a standing army, or a capitol city. The closest thing he had was a rag-tag band of followers, and a wooden cross on a hill outside of Jerusalem. Yet, he IS king, and, as he told Pilate, his kingdom is not of this world.

When will Christ's kingdom come to fruition? Our readings during the month of November, and even into December, give us hints of when, what, and how. Some of our readings are apocalyptic readings, readings that tell of the end of the world. These visions and descriptions can be quite strange, and sometimes rather frightening. They are not meant to be taken literally, and often are filled with symbolism, some of which we have figured out, but there is still a lot that we are not sure of. And that's okay! Christ IS King, is ruling now, and will rule forever.

"New Year's Day" for the church is the First Sunday of Advent, the first of four weeks where we light candles on the advent wreath, and prepare for Jesus' birth, not in a palace, but where animals were feeding. The year unfolds in mystery, quietly and unobtrusively (mostly!). In this coming new year, we will focus on gospel readings from Luke (with John thrown in from time to time). We will hear more about Jesus' "stealth" reign on earth, and his ultimate reign in heaven. May you be blessed as this year ends, and the new year dawns!

Council Highlights from October 9th, 2024

- MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: Craig Thies, Pastor Ann Zastrow, Kristy Henriksen, Ingrid Wielenberg, Cristy Appel, Karen Boehm, Robert Baerenwald, Nicole Weber, Lori Ilse, Thad Reinert, Mike Straw.
- TREASURER'S REPORT: A bill was received from Stout & Evink that was actually from the fairstand build in 2023. The bill had been mailed to the wrong place. That bill was paid thru Building Funds money. Motion made to accept the Treasurer's Report but to hold on the \$2000 Synod pledge for now.
 - PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor stated she would be gone for 2 Sundays in October and that those services will be covered. Confirmation will be held on Sunday, Oct. 27th with 4 confirmands.
- PRESIDENT'S REPORT: a suggested log of member visits to help with keeping track of mileage.
- VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Kristy and Pastor Ann have been doing online classes on reimaging meetings to help make them more productive. Kristy has planned a retreat for incoming 2025 Council members.
- PROPERTY MANAGEMENT: Trees & bushes have all been trimmed. Bell tower repair is completed. Money for that bill will come from funds designated to the Building Fund and the remaining balance will be paid by the Men's Account (aka. Meatball).
- WORSHIP COMMITTEE: The Christmas Eve service will be at 4pm (one service only). Looking ahead, May 11th with be Graduate Sunday (is also Mother's Day)
 - CONGREGATIONAL LIFE: the S'more bonfire went well. Time & Talents
 also discussed

- SUNDAY SCHOOL: We had over 40 kids attend the LIFT Kick-Off on September 29th. Background checks will be done on all volunteers as required by our insurance.
 - Craig has been calling members just to touch base with them. "It's been great to just sit and visit with our members."
- Steve Werner will head up a Fairstand Committee and will work to find members who are willing to help with that.
- Work has begun on having a short CONTEMPORARY SERVICE on the 2nd Wednesday of each month (November thru January). This will be in conjunction with LIFT and will include communion. The service will be led by members of our congregation. Future plans will depend on how well this is attended, etc.
- FINANCIAL STATEMENTS will be getting sent out again in November so members can plan for their year-end giving.
- Winter activities for families and kids were discussed: tubing, bowling, swimming (suggestions are welcome).
 - Work will begin on nominations for Committees & for 2025 Council.
 Current members need to let Lori know if they are serving another year.
 - Youth will serve at the Banquet on Oct. 23rd.






