Tis the Season to Rest, Reflect and Reignite

December is here! The days are getting shorter, the air is cold and crisp, snowflakes ride the winds at times. Thanksgiving winds up November, Black Friday kicks off the holiday shopping season, followed by Small Business Satur-

day and Cyber Monday, then Giving Tuesday. Gifts are purchased and wrapped, homes are decorated, Christmas music is heard in stores, homes, and churches, children have concerts and performances, Santa receives many wish lists, we cook and bake and clean, and we try to squeeze too many holiday events and activities into an already over-full schedule. For a season of love, peace and joy, sometimes (often?) things can seem too hectic and frazzled instead!

Sunday, December 1 is the First Sunday of Advent! This kicks off the new year for the church, and this year we will be focusing on the Gospel of Luke. This will provide us with many of the familiar stories of Christmas, including the angel's appearance to Mary, the Magnificat when Mary visits Elizabeth, the birth of John the Baptist, the birth of Jesus, the visits of the shepherds and the Magi/Wise Men. There is something comforting about hearing these familiar stories which makes the season all the more special (especially Linus's version in Charlie Brown Christmas).

Of course, the church will be decorated, we will light Advent candles during worship, and the LIFT kids will put on their Christmas Program (December 15, during worship). Kaffi-Ti provides an opportunity to pick up some baked goods that you don't bake in your own kitchen (the afternoon of Saturday, December 14). The candle-light Christmas Eve worship will be at 4 pm. The Sunday after Christmas (December 29) will be a service of lessons and carols.

I hope each of you can take some time to slow down, to rest, to reflect on what this season means. As the Grinch muses (paraphrased), maybe Christmas isn't about all the stuff – the tree, the packages and boxes and wrapping and bows, the food and Christmas cards/pictures/letters and decorations. Maybe Christmas is about something else, something that doesn't come from a store! Maybe it is spending time with family and friends, finding meaning in your faith, and seeing the holiday (and life!) through the eyes of a young one. Re-ignite your faith in God, and in humanity. Center, pray, reflect, observe, and be open to the quiet joy of the season.

- MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: Craig Thies, Pastor Ann Zastrow, Kristy Henriksen, Ingrid Wielenberg, Cristy Appel, Karen Boehm, Robert Baerenwald, Nicole Weber, Thad Reinert, Mike Straw, Marit Sterud. ABSENT: Lori Ilse
 - TREASURER'S REPORT: Bill discussed: Peak Pros bill for the bell tower: \$14,900 (from designated building fund money) & \$4000 from Men's Account. Tabled \$1000 payment to the Synod.
- PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastors vacation days in December were approved.
- PRESIDENT'S REPORT: There are still leaks in the bell tower. Have contacted Peak Pros. Coffee maker is in need of parts. Cost to replace it would be \$5000.
- VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Paint color for the kitchen will be picked out.
 Kristy will be attending the Churchwide Council of the ELCA in Chicago.
- PROPERTY MANAGEMENT: Replacing some flippers in the toilets & changing furnace filters.
 - CONGREGATIONAL LIFE: Ingrid is working on updating Time & Talent sheets. Working on possibly having a S'mores event in the Fellowship Hall.
 - SUNDAY SCHOOL: Need to work on a better way to transition from the contemporary service to LIFT. Christmas program is set for Dec. 15th.
 - ADULT ED: Robert requested to meet with Pastor to talk about ideas.
- YOUTH: Nicole is coordinating a K-5 & 6-12 shopping trip as well as a bowling Christmas party for 6-12 youth. Winter activities are being planned.

- Discussed the Wednesday night Contemporary Service. Ninety-four people attended (includes the LIFT kids). Need to have the sound louder.
- Office copier upgrade. Cost will be less than what we are currently paying.
 - Personnel committee Pastor will have names in a week.
- New members approved: Rose Anderson, Taylor Dunn & Robin Schulte.
 - Meatball Supper recap: 761 meals served, down about 100 from last year. Takeout meals were up.
- 2025 Budget discussed. Committee members Chuck S, Bob D., Nancy J. Need to be ready to review at the December 11th & January 8th meetings for Council to review. Final budget will be presented at the annual meeting on January 26th, 2025.
