LENT IS COMING!

The season of Lent is a penitential season, which starts Ash Wednesday, the Wednesday after we celebrate Transfiguration. This year, Ash Wednesday is March 5. Lent is 40 days long, plus 6 Sundays. Sundays are not included in the 40 days, because each Sunday is a "Little Easter," full of celebrating the joy of the



resurrection, a different vibe than the somberness of Lent.

Unlike Christmas, Easter has no specific "always" date. Sometimes it is a "late" Easter (in April), and sometimes it is an "early" Easter, in March. The earliest Easter can be is March 22, and the latest is April 25. Easter is the first Sunday after the first full moon after March 21 (spring equinox). If the full moon occurs on a Sunday, Easter is celebrated the following Sunday. So, counting back 46 days (including Sundays) determines when Ash Wednesday is. This year Easter is April 20, minus 46 days brings us to Wednesday, March 5 for Ash Wednesday.

Lent originally was a season of preparation of baptism, when catechumenates (candidates for baptism) would be taught (catechized) about the Christian faith. They would be baptized at the Easter Vigil service on Easter Saturday. They would be taught about Jesus, about the history of the church, the creeds and other beliefs of the church. This was an intense time! Baptism was a big deal early on, because becoming a Christian could cause rifts in families and communities. The person being baptized was turning their back on their former life, and taking up a new life as a follower of Jesus.

The same happens now in baptism, but in a different way. We usually baptize babies, who have no "say" in what is happening to them. Parents and sponsors/godparents promise to bring up the child in the Christian faith, teaching them the prayers, the creeds and the 10 Commandments. This would include bringing them to LIFT/Sunday school, worship, VBS, and other educational activities. They promise to put scripture in their hands, which we do at age 3 and grade 3. Parents do not do this alone! The congregation, representing the whole Church, promises to help parents keep these promises, as the early baptized Christians were surrounded and supported by their community of faith.

Lent is a good time to reflect on faith and life. There is a book series "40 Day Journey with..." all sorts of people – Martin Luther, Joan Chittester, and Parker Palmer are three of the series that I have. 

~Metal nail clipper (attached nail file optional)




Nail clippers, bath towels and combs are the items least donated.






