A Prayerful Advent for Families and Individuals

Dear Parish Family,

As we enter the sacred season of Advent, I invite each of you—families, couples, individuals—to make this time a prayerful journey toward the heart of Christ. Advent is not just a countdown to Christmas. It is a season of longing, hope, and preparation.

This year, we're encouraging every household to use the Magnificat Advent Companion 2025 as a daily guide. (We offer one to each household). It offers short reflections, Scripture readings, and beautiful prayers to help us stay focused on the true meaning of the season.

Simple Ways to Make Advent Prayerful:

- **Light your Advent wreath** together each evening and pray the blessing found in the Companion.
- **Read the daily Gospel reflection** and invite each family member to share a thought or feeling.
- **Bless your Christmas tree and Nativity scene** as sacred signs of God's presence in your home.
- **Practice the 7 Advent Stations**—one each week or during the final days before Christmas—to walk through salvation history as a family.
- **Offer acts of kindness:** visit someone who's lonely, write a note of encouragement, or serve together in the community.

Let this Advent be a time when Christ is welcomed not only into our churches, but into our homes, our conversations, and our hearts.

I will also have 3 Holy Hours with Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions. Here are the dates and times: **December 3, 6 pm to 7 pm at St. Mary in Guthrie Center; December 10, 6 pm to 7 pm at St. Patrick in Bayard; and December 18, 6 pm to 7 pm at St. Cecilia in Panora.**

Parish Invitation & Outreach

We are continuing our Volunteer Visitors Ministry—bringing comfort and companionship to the sick and elderly in homes, nursing facilities, and assisted living. If you feel called to serve, please sign up at the back of the church. Even one visit a month can make a world of difference. 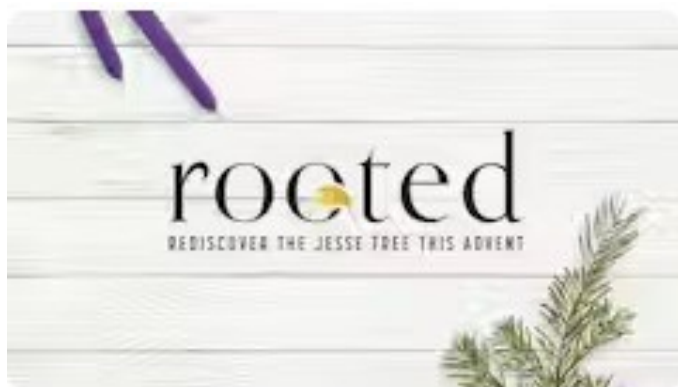
