1 Keep bathrooms and other areas clean.	Genesis 2:15 "The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it."	God calls us to be good stewards of the places He has given us.
2 Keep your space in the dorm clean.	1 Corinthians 14:40 "Everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way."	Keeping our space clean shows respect for roommates and creates a welcoming environment.
3 Be at all scheduled events and activities on time.	Colossians 3:23 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart."	Being present and punctual shows commitment, responsibility, and respect for others.
4 Be kind to each other. Lift each other up.	Romans 12:10 "Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves."	Camp should be a place where everyone feels valued, encouraged, and loved.
5 If you have an issue with another camper, go to your counselor.	Matthew 18:15 "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault..."	God calls us to handle conflict in healthy, respectful, and Christ-like ways.
6 No alcohol, drugs, smoking, or vaping.	1 Corinthians 6:19-20 "Your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit."	We honor God by caring for our bodies and making wise choices.
7 Guys are not allowed in Girls' Dorm area. Girls are not allowed in Guys' Dorm area.	1 Timothy 5:2 "...treat younger women as sisters, with absolute purity."	Healthy boundaries help create a safe environment and honor one another.
8 No PDA or physical contact of the dating kind.	1 Timothy 4:12 "...set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity."	Camp is a place to focus on God, friendships, and spiritual growth.
9 Only borrow possessions with permission.	Luke 6:31 "Do to others as you would have them do to you."	Respecting other people's belongings demonstrates kindness and integrity.
10 Treat the campground as your own. Do not damage property.	Philippians 2:4 "Not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."	Caring for shared spaces allows everyone to enjoy them and reflects respect for God's blessings.
11 Use common sense. If you are lacking it, stop and pray!	James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God..."	God promises wisdom to those who seek Him.
12 There is no such thing as a practical joke.	Ephesians 4:29 "Only what is helpful for building others up."	Our words and actions should encourage others, not embarrass or hurt them.
13 Consider others first and pray for each other.	Philippians 2:3-4 James 5:16 Put others first and pray for one another.	Christian community thrives when we put others first and lift each other up in prayer.

17 Put phones away during services, Bible studies, small groups, and prayer times.	Psalms 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God."	We want to give God our full attention and avoid distractions during spiritual activities.
18 Engage with the people around you instead of your phone.	Hebrews 10:24-25 "Encourage one another and spur each other on toward love and good deeds."	Camp is about building relationships, growing together, and creating memories that last.
