	6) Hosta, large leafed, 1 cultivar, 3 leaves
	7) Hosta, large leafed, 3 cultivars, 1 leaf of each cultivar
	8) Hosta, medium leafed, 1 cultivar, 3 leaves
	9) Hosta, medium leafed, 3 cultivars, 1 leaf each cultivar
	10) Hosta, miniature, 1 cultivar, 3 leaves
	11) Hosta, miniature, 3 cultivars, 1 leaf each cultivar
	12) Dianthus (Pinks), 3 stems
	13) Hemerocallis (Daylily), 1 stalk
	14) Iris, bearded, 1 stalk
	15) Iris, Siberian, 1 stalk
	16) Iris, any other variety, 1 stalk
	17) Lilium (lily), 1 stalk
	18) Oriental Poppy, 1 bloom
	19) Peony, single, 1 bloom
	20) Peony, double, 1 bloom
	21) Peony, semi-double, 1 bloom
	22) Peony, any other kind, 1 bloom
	23) Rose, hybrid tea, Peace, 1 bloom
	24) Rose, hybrid tea, not Peace, 1 bloom
	25) Rose, floribunda, 1 stem
	26) Rose, grandiflora, 1 stem
	27) Rose, climber/rambler, 1 stem
	28) Rose, shrub, 1 stem

	32) Any other perennial or biennial, 1 stem
	33) Any other perennial or biennial, 3 stems
	34) Any other flowering bulb, corm or tuber, 1 stem, spike or spray
	35) Container of flowers, 1 species only
	36) Container of flowers, 3 or more species
	37) Flowering tree/shrub, 1 branch, not to exceed 1 metre
	38) Foliage branch, 1 branch, not to exceed 1 metre
	39) Any other flowering vine, not to exceed 1 metre
	40) Any other perennial or biennial not listed above
<b>Plan to Enter</b>	<b>Section B – Plants</b>
	1) African Violet, 1 crown
	2) Cactus
	3) Succulent
	4) Any plant not listed.
	5) Geranium - Pelargonium
	6) Herb, 1 plant variety

	1) A Collection of Herbs - up to 5 varieties, displayed attractively in water, must be named.

Plan to Enter	Section D – Design Theme – FIFA FEVER
1)	CANADA - A parallel design, OJES p. 146, 3 or more groupings with open space between them
2)	ENGLAND - A one-sided mass design in a basket with a handle
3)	CURACAO - A miniature design, OJES p. 145, maximum 12.7 cm (5”) in height, width, and depth including container and/or accessories
4)	JAPAN - A water design, OJES p. 156, a water-viewing design in a shallow container with ½ to 2/3 of the container surface showing water
5)	NEW ZEALAND - A satellite design, OJES p. 150, a design with a main unit and a smaller unit of the same colour, form, and texture that do not touch but have a connective line joining them
6)	BRAZIL - A pave design, OJES p. 147, groups of plant material cut short, placed close together to form undulating mounds of colours, textures, shapes and sizes in a low container
7)	DESIGNER’S CHOICE - Create a design to celebrate FIFA in Toronto using your favourite type of design
8)	<p>MEXICO - A small mass design, OJES p. 150, less than 25.4 cm (10”) in height, width, and depth including container and/or accessories</p> <p><b>8a – EXPERIENCED EXHIBITOR</b></p> <p><b>8b – NOVICE EXHIBITOR</b> – never won a first-place ribbon in any floral design category in an annual show at Riverdale Horticultural Society.</p>
