USA Volleyball-Aligned Parent Code of Conduct

Purpose

To foster a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators involved in USA Volleyball-sanctioned events.

Expectations for Parents

Supportive Behavior

- Encourage your child and their teammates with positive reinforcement.
- Refrain from coaching your child or other players during practices or games.

Respect for All Participants

- Treat all athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect, regardless of race, gender, religion, or background.
- Avoid any form of harassment, discrimination, or bullying.

Compliance with USAV Policies

- Abide by all USAV and regional rules, including SafeSport and MAAPP guidelines.
- Do not possess, consume, or distribute alcohol, tobacco, vaping devices, or illegal substances at junior events.

Sportsmanship

- Demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.
- Avoid yelling at referees, coaches, or players.
- Accept decisions made by officials as part of the game.

Safety and Welfare

- Promote a safe and healthy environment for all participants.
- Report any concerns regarding abuse, misconduct, or unsafe behavior to event organizers or SafeSport authorities.

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Event Conduct

- Follow venue rules and regulations.
- Ensure your child arrives on time and prepared for practices and games.
- Avoid disruptive behavior that could interfere with the event.

Violations

Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Removal from the event venue.
- Suspension from future events.
- Revocation of membership privileges by USAV or its Regions.
