Kudos to Steve De Korte, Marty Caraway and Mitchell Lumber for their donations of materials needed to build the shed.

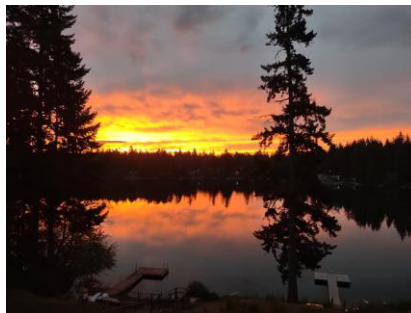
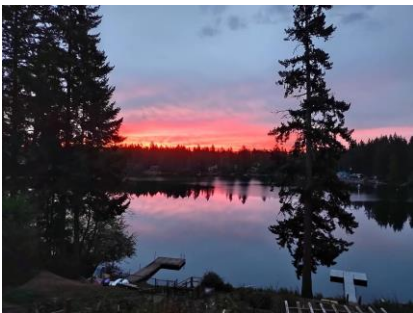

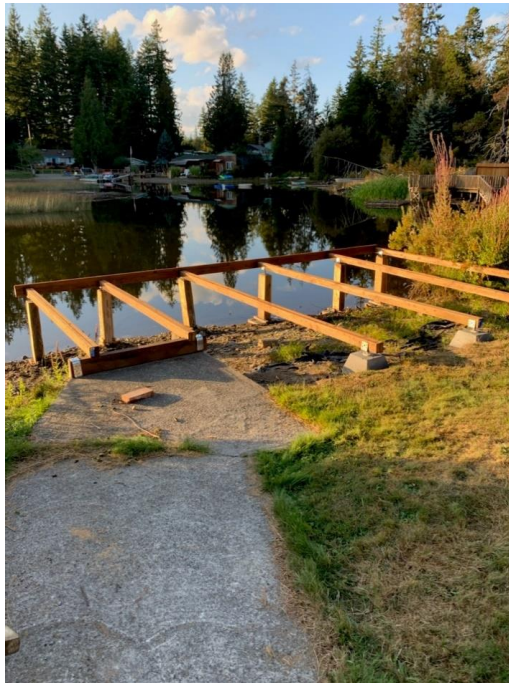
### **THANK YOU TRAILS END LAKE COMMUNITY**
