BOARD OFFICERS & DIRECTORS

The TECC community has some challenging days ahead if we can't get members to stop up and start running for the board officers and directors. Almost all are serving terms past what the By-Laws state they can hold their positions. Officers are elected for a 1-year term and Directors are elected for a 2-year term. With the exception of 2 officers (not including our two newest board members), 7 members are well over 50 and are getting tired of keeping the club operating with no members stepping up to run and getting voted in to hold these positions. In our next few issues, we are going to highlight our men and women who are serving on the board and provide a brief description of what each position does. If we do not get more people to step up and run for office so our older members can retire from their position, then the club will have some hard decisions to make about the future of the TECC and disposition of their properties. Please read each position, as they are presented and if there is one that interests you, reach out and shadow the current officer/director and see what they do and how much time they spend doing their job.

We just did a mass postcard mailing to all residents that live in the TECC area, in an effort introduce our club to all residents and to encourage the residents to come check out the club and get involved. We have some great events happening monthly (check website for the tentative list of events for the year). But we need our members to step up and get more involved.

We first introduced Sue Provato, VP of Ways & Means. We also met John Provato, VP of Grounds. Both are also filling in as Directors for the club. Both are leaving at the end of their term at the end of the year and these 4 positions need to be filled.

Now we are going to introduce Teresa and Rob Elliott, who are currently each as a director. Per Rob, a director is involved with club activities. We attend all meetings and hear proposals, discuss functions and discuss spending the club's money for club asset upkeep and other various functions. We are members of the governing body of TECC.

Let me introduce myself to you. I'm Karen Jordan, currently holding the position of Treasurer since February 2021 to now along with starting up the newsletter and creating the website. The newsletter position consists of getting articles with news from around the lake that our members should be aware of, i.e. events happening, club responsibilities, etc. The website is getting that same information up on the website for those that don't get the newsletter but is interested in club news. We always have our membership application form in our newsletter along with the forms for the club house rental and Friendship Park rentals.

Now that being said I'll switch over to my other hat - Treasurer. It is my responsibility as the club treasurer to account for all club funds received for memberships and other items along with making sure all the club bills are paid timely. Monthly reports are presented to the board to summarize the monthly activities. I also keep a listing of the membership in the club to ensure that all membership payments are routed through me and then membership cards can be issued. It is my responsibility to ensure that the club funds are invested wisely and used prudently to ensure that we don't overspend or extend ourselves on money management.

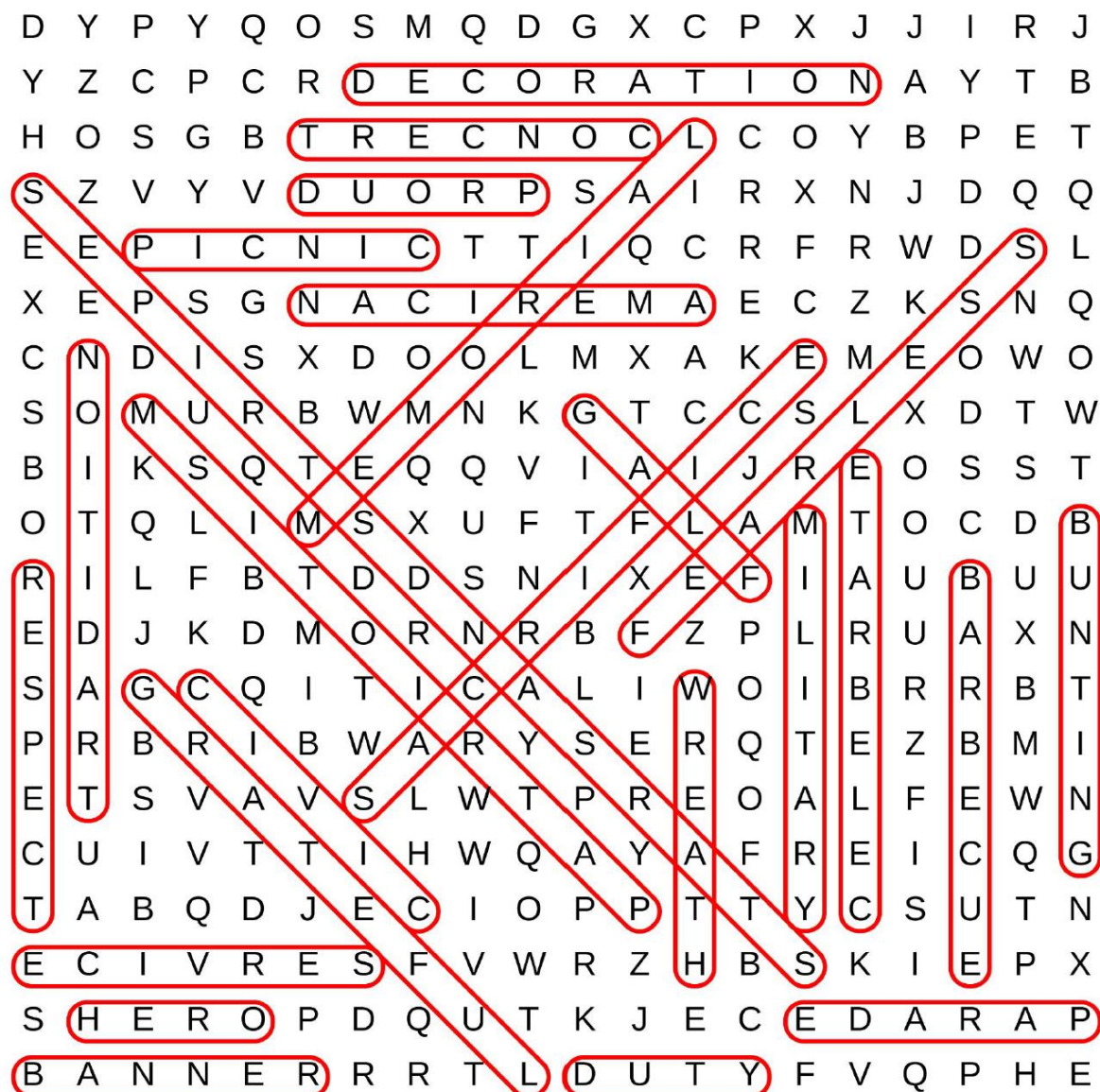

Welcome to Trails End Community **Membership Application**

Welcome to the Trails End Community. We host many activities that we would love to see each and every one of you participate in with us. Join us and meet your neighbors. Past events have included Bingo, Bunco, Rummage Sale, Fishing Derby, Pancake Breakfast, Spring Bake Sale, Santa Around the Lake, Flag Retirement Ceremony (honoring our many Veterans), Ice Cream in the Park & our annual Brown Bag Auction in July at Friendship Beach & Park.

Enjoy Friendship Park with a playground for the kids and a dock to swim from (at your own risk)! Use North Beach to dock your boats, canoes, kayaks, etc. and sit for a spell on the new dock with seating available. Salt Water Beach at the corner of State Route 106 & East Trails Road is great for clamming, hunting oysters, wading in the Hood Canal, etc. Plenty of opportunities to keep busy year-round. The clubhouse is available for rent or Friendship Park for private events at a reduced cost as a member.

Watch the Reader Board on the corner of E Trails End Dr. for monthly events. Events will also be posted on our website at www.trailsendcommunityclub.org and if we have your e-mail we send out a newsletter periodically along with e-mail blasts for upcoming events or to alert you about critical alerts for our community.

The TECC membership dues are \$75.00 for up to six members in a household, each additional person up to eleven members are an additional \$10 each. Membership year is January 1 – December 31. Your membership fees help maintain our properties: 1) Friendship Beach & Park; 2) North Beach; 3) Salt Water Beach @ St Rt 106/E Trails End Dr and the parking lot there; and 4) Clubhouse & Grounds. The dues also help pay for insurance, utilities, necessary repairs, port-a-potty in the summer at Friendship Beach & Park & trash service at the Clubhouse & Friendship Beach & Park. Some projects that are in the works to be done over the next several years include replacing the dock at Friendship Park and reworking the retaining walls at the clubhouse.

Members may rent the Clubhouse for \$50.00 for personal use: parties, weddings & family events, etc.

TECC Clubhouse is an emergency shelter which has supplies, trained volunteers and a generator to use with loss of power. The club also has a 2-way radio with MASCOM & an AED (defibrillator) for emergencies.

It is very important that you fill out the membership application completely so we can identify your mailing address versus your property address. The Membership form MUST accompany payment. Membership cards cannot be delivered to you if we do not have your mailing address. Also, if you have more than one e-mail or phone # to also provide us with both so we have another avenue to contact you with quickly. We do maintain a membership database, so we have your correct information to use in an emergency. The database is for TECC use only and is not shared with anyone outside of the TECC Board.

10. PLEASE KEEP OUR PARKS CLEAN AND SAFE FOR YOU AND FOR OUR CHILDREN.
11. PARK MUST BE RESERVED IN ADVANCE FOR PRIVATE PARTIES. ABOVE RULES STILL APPLY.
12. PARENTAL SUPERVISION FOR ALL CHILDREN TWELVE AND UNDER AT ALL TIMES.
13. NOISE LEVELS, INCLUDING MUSIC, SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BE LOUD ENOUGH TO BE OFFENSIVE TO OR DISTURB THE NEIGHBORS.
14. FOUL LANGUAGE IS NOT PERMITTED IN FRIENDSHIP PARK/BEACH AS THE PARK IS FAMILY ORIENTED.

TRAILS END COMMUNITY CLUB BUILDING RENTAL CONTRACT

1. The daily rental fee of \$50.00 for Members and \$150.00 for Non-Members and a damage/key deposit of \$300.00 in the form of cash or money order must be paid in advance. If there is no damage and the key is returned, the damage deposit will be returned at the time of the final walk-through. If damage should occur, the balance of the damage deposit will be returned after an estimate for repairs is established by the Community Club. The rental fee for the BINGO machine is \$25.00.
2. When the application is approved, the **RENTER** will be notified and arrangements will be made for the **RENTER** and Community Club representative to do a walk-through of the facility. They will complete a checklist, noting the condition of the building at that time. Prior to, or upon completion of the activity, the **RENTER** will make arrangements for a second walk-through, which will be conducted after the event/activity, to again complete the check list and return the key.
3. **RENTERS** must provide their own eating & beverage utensils (plates, glasses, cups, silverware, napkins, etc.) as well as any food or drinks. **These items WILL NOT be provided by the Community Club.**
4. **NON-MEMBER RENTERS** using the building for fund raisers or other large group public activities, shall be required to provide a certificate of liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 naming the Trails End Community Club as an insured.
5. There will be **NO SMOKING** in the building during the event/activity. There will be **NO ALCOHOL** allowed on the premises.
6. The kitchen countertops shall be protected from damage, excessive heat or from cutting. Insulation mats & cutting boards will be available upon request.
7. The building shall be cleaned & all trash removed prior to the final walk-through. Removal & disposal of all trash and garbage shall be the responsibility of the **RENTER**.
8. During rental periods, noise levels, including music, shall not be permitted to be loud enough to be offensive to or disturb the neighbors.
9. Upon receipt of the Rental Fee & Damage/Key Deposit, & at the time of the first walk-through, the **RENTER** will be provided a key to the building.

T.E.C.C. RENTAL CONTRACT for FRIENDSHIP BEACH SHELTER

**The entire park, playground, dock and beach are private domain for paid T.E.C.C. members.
Only the covered shelter is available for rental for a private event.**

1. Daily rental fee is \$35.00 for T.E.C.C. Members. **A \$50.00 deposit is required as well to be returned to the renter provided that the park shelter is returned in the condition it was found during initial walk through.**

2. When the application is approved, the Renter will be notified, and arrangements will be made for the Renter and Community Club representative to do a walk-through of the park shelter. They will do a walk-through noting the condition of the shelter at that time. Prior to, or upon completion of the activity, the Renter will make arrangements for a second walk-through, which will be conducted after the event/activity.

3. There will be **NO SMOKING** in the shelter during the event/activities. There will be **NO ALCOHOL** allowed on the premises.

4. The shelter shall be cleaned & all trash removed prior to the final walk-through. Removal & disposal of all trash & garbage shall be the responsibility of the Renter.

5. **During rental periods, noise levels, including music shall not be permitted to be loud enough to be offensive to, or disturb the neighbors. Foul language is not permitted in Friendship Beach as the park is family oriented.**

6. **No Dogs** are allowed at Friendship Beach Park, in order to keep the area sanitary for our families to come and enjoy the park and beach area.

7. All Friendship Park rules remain in place during all rentals.

Disregarding these rules will mean immediate forfeiture of the current rental deposit and the right for future rentals.
