


#### VARIANCE REQUEST FILED FOR 211 E TRAILS END DR, BELFAIR

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: TRAILS END DIV. #2, LOT 1, BLOCK #2, SW OF SE QUARTER OF SEC 23, TWN 22N, R 2 W. PARCEL NUMBER: 22223-51-02001

As you can see from the picture above of the Notice of Application and Public Hearing for Shoreline Variance, the owner has requested a variance to build a residential building within the shoreline buffer of Trails End Lake. The proposed development is reviewed as a Shoreline Variance under Section 17.50.255 of the Mason County Shoreline Master Program. A Public Hearing on this proposed project will take place on Wednesday, June 22, 2022 at 1:00 PM via Zoom.

Written and oral testimony will be accepted up to the close of the hearing. Any person wishing to express their views or tobe notified of the action taken on the application should express their views or interests by <u>June 20</u>, <u>2022</u>. Now with the legal information has been put on the table, the TECC is very concerned with this proposed variance due to the fact that the proposed variance request for the distance that they can build, along with possible septic, from the outflow of Trails End Lake and the lake itself. The property owners have already started clearing the trees out (see the sattelite & Mason County GIS maps on next page). We need your help sending in e-mails opposing the variance request.





Most of this property is steep slope, with the shoreline somewhat marshy and is directly on the dam with beaver activity. Outflow of the lake is into Puget Sound. TECC is deeply concerned as this property is on the backside of our property with a steep slope. With the removal of trees and brush, we are concerned that our property could potential start sliding down towards the outflow of Trails End Lake damaging our property and devaluing our property values. Not to mention the possibility of a potential insurance claim to have to deal with. Here are seven pictures taken of this property right behind the TECC clubhouse and TEWD.















#### Potential issues that we see:

- With the close proximity of the structure/septic to the outflow dam and downstream wildlife, it affects the actual lake water that is our resource for recreation, to put in a proper and safe septic system on this small parcel of land, thus exposing the outflow of Trails End Lake to raw sewage which would pollute the water usage and flow into Puget Sound and the lake itself
- This potential pollution would jeopardize our lake water for the residents around the lake and in the area, causing additional expense to clean up the pollution to keep our lake water safe for recreational use on Trails End Lake itself along with the water that drains into Puget Sound.
- The impact to TECC property that abuts their two properties in question, with a steeply sloped wall, that is currently held in place by trees and green growth. With the removal of the trees and green growth, the question is raised about the eventual need to add a retaining wall or something that would prevent our property from sliding down the hill due to eventual erosion.
- The shoreline is somewhat marshy and is directly on the dam with beaver activity.
- ♣ Other wildlife that inhabits this parcel of land would be dislocated from their habitat.

Team Montesano, Washington Fish and Wildlife,

This note to give you a heads up, if you were not already aware, of the owner of this property requesting a variance to the distance they can build (along with possible septic) from the outflow of Trails End Lake and the lake itself. There is a public hearing on June 22 regarding the variance to the buffer on Trails End Lake.

I enclosed the owners name of this property where they have started clearing trees already, their location in the Mason County GIS and a SAT map (attached in PowerPoint).

Most of this property is steep slope, the shoreline is somewhat marshy and is directly on the dam with beaver activity. Outflow of the lake is into Puget Sound. If you get a chance you should come by and see the property itself and assess if a variance to the buffer is a good idea. Thanks for listening,



#### TRAILS END COMMUNITY CLUB BUILDING RENTAL CONTRACT

- 1. The daily rental fee of \$50.00 for Members and \$150.00 for Non-Members and a damage/key deposit of \$300.00 in the form of cash or money order must be paid in advance. If there is no damage and the key is returned, the damage deposit will be returned at the time of the final walk-through. If damage should occur, the balance of the damage deposit will be returned after an estimate for repairs is established by the Community Club. The rental fee for the BINGO machine is \$25.00.
- 2. When the application is approved, the **RENTER** will be notified, and arrangements will be made for the **RENTER** and Community Club representative to do a walk-through of the facility. They will complete a checklist, noting the condition of the building at that time. Prior to, or upon completion of the activity, the **RENTER** will make arrangements for a second walk-through, which will be conducted after the event/activity, to again complete the check list and return the key.
- **3. RENTERS** must provide their own eating & beverage utensils (plates, glasses, cups, silverware, napkins, etc.) as well as any food or drinks. **These items WILL NOT be provided by the Community Club.**
- **4. NON-MEMBER RENTERS** using the building for fund raisers or other large group public activities, shall be required to provide a certificate of liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 naming the Trails End Community Club as an insured.
- 5. There will be **NO SMOKING** in the building during the event/activity. There will be **NO ALCOHOL** allowed on the premises.
- **6.** The kitchen countertops shall be protected from damage, excessive heat or from cutting. Insulation mats & cutting boards will be available upon request.
- **7.** The building shall be cleaned & all trash removed prior to the final walk-through. Removal & disposal of all trash and garbage shall be the responsibility of the **RENTER.**
- **8.** During rental periods, noise levels, including music, shall not be permitted to be loud enough to be offensive to or disturb the neighbors.
- **9.** Upon receipt of the Rental Fee & Damage/Key Deposit, & at the time of the first walkthrough, the **RENTER** will be provided a key to the building.

### T.E.C.C. RENTAL CONTRACT for FRIENDSHIP BEACH SHELTER

The entire park, playground, dock, and beach are private domain for paid T.E.C.C. members. Only the covered shelter is available for rental for a private event.

- 1. Daily rental fee is \$35.00 for T.E.C.C Members. <u>A \$50.00 deposit is required as well to be returned to the renter provided that the park shelter is returned in the condition it was found during initial walk thru.</u>
- 2. When the application is approved, the Renter will be notified, and arrangements will be made for the Renter and Community Club representative to do a walk-through of the park shelter. They will do a walk-through noting the condition of the shelter at that time. Prior to, or upon completion of the activity, the Renter will make arrangements for a second walk-through, which will be conducted after the event/activity.
- 3. There will be **NO SMOKING** in the shelter during the event/activities. There will be **NO ALCOHOL** allowed on the premises.
- 4. The shelter shall be cleaned & all trash removed prior to the final walk-through. Removal & disposal of all trash & garbage shall be the responsibility of the Renter.
- 5. <u>During rental periods, noise levels, including music shall not be permitted to be loud enough to be offensive to, or disturb the neighbors. Foul language is not permitted in Friendship Beach as the park is family oriented.</u>
- 6. **No Dogs** are allowed at Friendship Beach Park, in order to keep the area sanitary for our families to come and enjoy the park and beach area.

<u>Disregarding these rules will mean immediate forfeiture of the current rental deposit and the right</u> for future rentals.
