The Period of Fasting & Praying: 20 March 2023 – 9 April 2023

DAILY PRAYER OF CONCENTRATION & SCRIPTURES

SUNDAYS: Seek God and Draw near to Him.

Matthew 6:33 – But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. (ESV) James 4:8 – Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world. (NLT)

MONDAYS: 2020 Vision & Beyond and Capital Campaign.

Habakkuk 2:2 – And the LORD answered me: "Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it. (ESV)

TUESDAYS: Local & national Leaders and Communities.

Isaiah 64:9 - Don't be so angry with us, LORD. Please don't remember our sins forever. Look at us, we pray, and see that we are all your people. (NLT)

Isaiah 61:1-11 – ¹The Spirit of the Lord GoD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; ² to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; ³ to grant to those who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit; that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he may be glorified... ¹⁰ I will greatly rejoice in the LORD; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. ¹¹ For as the earth brings forth its sprouts, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to sprout up, so the Lord GoD will cause righteousness and praise to sprout up before all the nations.
