Jonathan Tarr Foundation (JTF) Scholarship

One high school recipient will be awarded the JTF Scholarship. To be eligible you <u>must submit</u> <u>your FASFA receipt</u> for the 2024-2025 academic year with your application.

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Required Enclosures

- [1] Complete and submit page 1 of application.
- [2] Recent Photo must be submitted with application.
- [3] Official High School Transcipts must be ordered through school and the most recent transcript is required, January 2024. Transcripts MUST be signed, stamped with school official seal and be in a sealed envelope when submitted. This must be mailed with application or provide proof of receipt, it was ordered by April 1st.
- [4] Letter of acceptance to a community college, or university or trade school.
- [5] <u>TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION ARE REQUIRED and must be signed and dated by the recommender.</u> Recommenders may email letters to PIFA directly.
 - (1) school teacher or counselor
 - (2) community leader or employer
- [6] <u>ESSAY FORMAT</u> answering questions and topics involving accomplishments, leadership or scholastic honors/awards, Pacific Islander and community involvement/service, goals for the future and how you plan to contribute back to PIFA. Be sure to follow the categories below.
- [7] A copy of receipt of submission for FAFSA 2024-2025 must be submitted to be eligible for JTF Scholarship).
- [8] Proof of ethnicity (Melanesian, Micronesian or Polynesian descent). Examples: Birth certificate, parent(s) or grandparent(s) birth certificate, religious registry, etc.NOTE: Applicant may submit additional written work, photos, video and other materials etc. Applicants will be scored using a 5-Point rubric created by the PIFA Scholarship Committee for evaluation. Please examine each category carefully when submitting your application.

ESSAY MUST BE INCLUDED WITH APPLICATION

Tell us about yourself (BIO - Example: What Pacific Islander community you represent, what school are you graduating from, what school will you be attending in the fall, what is your major field of study, etc.

Be sure to also include in your essay, the following categories:

Category 1: High School Academics

- Strength of academic program, as evidence by the number of advanced placement or honors courses completed.
- Cumulative rank.
- College weighted grade point average

Category 2: Community Service

- Community service (e.g., tutoring, mentoring, volunteer work, fundraising, etc.)
- Leadership skills (e.g., executive positions in any organization, leading youth groups, school or civic involvement)
- Civic involvement (e.g., participating in public/private partnerships, volunteering on behalf of city programs and services, addressing/advocating the city council on issues of interest to the community, etc.)

Category 3: Participating In Promoting Culture

- Cultural Arts or Dance Groups
- Community work within the Pacific Islander community

Category 4: Potential Goals to Contribute to Communities of Pacific Islanders

- How applicant will give back to Pacific Islander community
- Native language skills
- Knowledge of your Pacific Islander ancestry

Category 5: Letters of Recommendation

Must have a minimum of two letters of recommendation submitted with application.
