GLEUSTEEN-ORDRONNEAU DUO

Since 1999 when they first began to work together, Kai Gleusteen and Catherine Ordronneau have established themselves as one of the most important European violin and piano duos. Having performed more than 100 recitals in Europe, Canada and the USA, they are praised for their unique partnership, "playing under the control of a single intelligence", and for the emotional power of their interpretations.

Recent projects include touring the USA in performance with the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra, recitals in both Chicago and San Francisco, a 21-concert tour of China, a gala concert in the prestigious Hôtel de Ville of Paris and active participation in the Kaimerata Festivals in Spain and Canada.

Their repertoire encompasses most of the great sonatas for violin and piano — including complete Beethoven sonatas and Brahms sonatas — as well as a myriad of short pieces representing the countries where they perform. They have recorded extensively on the AVIE label.

ITINERARY

Day 1 / Fri, April 18: DEPART CANADA

Depart for Germany

Day 2 / Sat, April 19: ARRIVE MUNICH

After arrival, check into hotel. Time to relax and then join your hosts Kai Gleusteen and Catherine Ordronneau for a welcome drink. Get to know your fellow travelers during the first dinner (D)

Day 3 / Sun, April 20: MUNICH

Introduction to the city during our orientation tour. See the main sites and get an overview of the city's lively and dramatic history. We also visit the Alte Pinakothek (The Old Masters). Have a short break and then it is time for our first music performance after dinner (B,D)

Day 4 / Mon, April 21: MUNICH

Visit and tour of Nymphenburg Palace, and music related visit in Munich / time at leisure (optional visits like: Neue Pinakothek/ etc.) — evening dinner at the historic Hofbrauhaus (B,D)

Day 5 / Tue, April 22: MUNICH

Day trip to the foothills of the Alps. We tour Linderhof Castle (learn about King Ludwig, Richard Wagner). Then we spend time in picturesque Oberammergau, the famous Passionplay location in the Alps. We tour the Passionplay House and there is time to enjoy the painted houses of the village before returning to Munich. After dinner we attend another Classical Music event (B,D)

Day 6 / Wed, April 23: MUNICH — BAD ISCHL — VIENNA

Morning departure from Munich and stop in Bad Ischl, one of the 3 European Culture Capitals 2024 (the others are Tartu/Estonia and Bodo/Norway — we visit the Kaiservilla, where descendants of the Austrian Habsburg family live to this date. We also learn about Franz Lehar, famous for his Operettas. He spent the last part of his life in Bad Ischl. Then we travel on to the capital. After arrival in Vienna, we check into the Grand Hotel Wien, opened in 1870, a living example of Viennese charm and personalized service. This historic hotel will be your home base for the week. (B,D)

Day 7 / Thu, April 24: VIENNA

Start your exploration of the Austrian capital with an orientation tour. See the highlights of the Ringstrasse and UNO City, one of the four official headquarters of the United Nations. Lunch at one of Vienna's traditional cafes. Enjoy a 2-hour guided walking tour through the Inner City, past St. Stephen's Cathedral and other landmarks. Tonight, proceed to the Musikverein for the first of your concerts. (B,L)

Day 8 / Fri, April 25: VIENNA

Embark on a guided tour of the Great Hall of the Musikverein, widely considered to be one of the finest concert halls in the world, thanks to its superb acoustics. Continue to the Haus der Musik, an interactive museum dedicated to the world of sound. This afternoon, proceed to Vienna Zentral Friedhof, the second largest cemetery in the world and resting place of famous musicians such as Beethoven, Brahms, Schubert and Strauss. Return to the hotel to rest before tonight's dinner and concert. (B,D)

Day 9 / Sat, April 26: VIENNA

This morning, enjoy a brief walking tour of the historic centre with its narrow streets and hidden courtyards. End with a visit to the Mozarthaus, the composer's residence from 1784 to 1787. In this very special setting, enjoy a private concert by your hosts. Afternoon at leisure to further explore Vienna on your own. You may wish to visit the Art History Museum, the Belvedere or the Albertina, or one of the renowned museums in the Museum Quarter. Tonight we have a special dinner at one of Vienna's finest addresses (B,D)

Day 10 / Sun, April 27: VIENNA

Morning concert with the Vienna Boys Choir at the Hofburgkapelle. This afternoon, visit and tour Schönbrunn Palace, main summer residence of the Habsburg rulers, inextricably linked to Empress Maria Theresa. (B,D)

Day 11 / Mon, April 28: VIENNA – EISENSTADT – VIENNA

Full day excursion to Eisenstadt. Discover the grand Esterházy Palace, where classical composer Joseph Haydn spent much of his career as a court musician. Lunch at a typical local brewery restaurant. Visit the Haydn Mausoleum in the nearby Bergkirche. Return to Vienna for some time at leisure before our evening program. Tonight's dinner plans are left up to you, a chance to try out one of the many great restaurants of the city. (B,L)

Day 12 / Tue, April 29: VIENNA – VIENNA WOODS – VIENNA

Today travel to the Vienna Woods and visit the monastery of Heiligenkreuz. Take part in the noon hour chants of the monks, before enjoying lunch at the monastery's restaurant. After lunch, drive through the St. Helena Valley to nearby Baden, long a refuge for the Viennese nobility. Enjoy a walking tour of the lovely Biedermeier town centre, as well as an exclusive visit to the Beethovenhaus, where the composer spent his summers between 1821 and 1823 and wrote substantial parts of the 9th Symphony. Return to Vienna for your farewell dinner. (B,L,D)

Day 13 / Wed, April 30 DEPART VIENNA – ARRIVE CANADA

Flight home or continuation of your European adventure on your own (B)

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

TOUR PRICES:
