Catherine Ordronneau & Kai Gleusteen

Canadian born violinist, **Kai Gleusteen**, finished his post-secondary studies in the US, having studied at University of Michigan and Rice University under the tutelage of Camilla Wicks. Since 1990, he has lived in Europe. Almost 10 years in France, a year in Prague and since 2000, in Barcelona, as concertmaster of the Gran Teatre del Liceu Symphony Orchestra. He continues to perform world-wide with Catherine Ordronneau.

French born pianist, **Catherine Ordronneau** enjoys a diverse musical life, sharing her time between teaching and performing. She is equally at ease performing concertos with orchestra as in solo recitals, having a preference of being able to share the stage with her favourite colleagues. She has been a professor of piano and chamber music in the Conservatorio Superior del Liceu in Barcelona since 2008 and Kai's partner in life and chamber music over 25 years.

Day 01 Feb 28, Sat:	Canada to Nairobi, Kenya Board your international flight to Nairobi
Day 02 Mar 01, Sun	Welcome to Nairobi – A Grand Opening As your plane touches down at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you're greeted by the warm smiles of our hosts and the vibrant rhythm of East Africa. A flute of bubbly, cool towels, and an authentic safari hat await — your journey begins in style. Unwind at the luxurious JW Marriott Nairobi. The evening is yours to relax, acclimate, and anticipate the extraordinary days ahead.
Day 03 Mar 02, Mon	Gentle Giants & Colonial Elegance Today, you meet Kenya's iconic wildlife in an intimate, unforgettable way. At the Daphne Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, young elephants rescued from the wild tug at your heartstrings as they tumble through their morning mud bath. Next, rise eye-to-eye with Rothschild giraffes at the Giraffe Centre, feeding them from your palm — a moment of delight and connection. Over lunch at the serene Karen Blixen Coffee Garden, soak in the atmosphere of the writer's former estate before exploring her beautifully preserved colonial home. Your artistic sensibilities are then treated to the vibrant craftsmanship at Kazuri Bead Factory, where bold, hand-crafted jewelry made by women artisans reflects Kenya's soul. Tonight, a special welcome dinner awaits — hosted (subject to availability) in the Manji Family Residence, a historic Nairobi home. (B,L)
Day 04 Mar 03, Tue	A Day of Leisure and Music Enjoy a relaxed morning with Nairobi at your fingertips. Whether sipping coffee poolside or exploring one of the out of town excursions — a tea luncheon on a colonial farm, a coffee-tasting experience, or a full day on an artisanal regenerative food campus — the choices are immersive and authentic. As dusk settles, guests will gather for a private, invitation-only performance by Kai and Catherine — an intimate concert set against Nairobi's cultural backdrop, sure to become a treasured memory. Day 05 Mar 04, Wed	Into the Wild – Samburu Awaits This morning, journey north into the dramatic beauty of Samburu. Arrive at your luxurious riverside camp in time for a delicious lunch, followed by your first game drive through the semi-arid savannah — home to unique northern species like the graceful gerenuk and reticulated giraffe. Tonight, dine under stars that shimmer above a truly wild frontier, where the hush of the night is broken only by distant animal calls. (B,L,D)
Day 06 Mar 05, Thu	The Secrets of Samburu A full day in Samburu's starkly beautiful wilderness begins with a game drive at dawn, as the landscape stirs to life. Graceful gerenuk stretch for leaves, Grevy's zebras roam in striking patterns, and elephants cross the Ewaso Nyiro River, the lifeblood of the region. Later, you'll visit a traditional Samburu Manyatta, where you'll be welcomed into the rhythm of daily life. Discover the deep-rooted customs, vivid adornments, and remarkable resilience of this proud seminomadic community — an immersive cultural encounter that offers a rare window into Kenya's ancestral heart. An afternoon game drive completes your day, before dinner under the stars. (B,L,D)
Day 07 Mar 06, Fri	Legacy of Ol Pejeta Today's journey brings you to Ol Pejeta Conservancy — a place of poignant beauty and ecological importance. Once the private playground of Adnan Kashoggi, it now hosts orphaned chimpanzees and the world's last two northern white rhinos. Game drives here offer astonishing wildlife encounters, with Mount Kenya rising in the background. Toast the evening in colonial-inspired luxury as you imagine the grandeur of early 20th-century safaris. (B,L,D)
Day 08 Mar 07, Sat	Wildlife and Wonder Two immersive game drives take you deeper into this extraordinary landscape. Lions stalk the grasslands, rhinos lumber past acacia trees, and countless bird species animate the skies. In between adventures, perhaps sip tea as Kai and Catherine share musical reflections — a tranquil interlude in the heart of wild Kenya. (B,L,D)







Day 09 Mar 08, Sun	Soysambu Sundowners En route to the picturesque Soysambu Conservancy, pause at Thompson's Falls before reaching your lakeside retreat. After a relaxing lunch, set off on a scenic game drive culminating in a private sundowner high above Lake Elementaita. Champagne in hand, watch the African sun melt into the horizon; a scene worthy of Debussy or Dvořák. (B,L,D)
Day 10 Mar 09, Mon	The Legendary Masai Mara After breakfast, venture into the famed Masai Mara — one of the last great theatres of the wild. Game drive en route to camp, then spend the afternoon surrounded by Africa's Big Five and sweeping savannahs. Evening brings fireside stories and culinary delights, enveloped by the sounds of the bush. (B,L,D)
Day 11 & 12 Mar 10 & 11, Tue & Wed	Drama on the Plains Two days of extraordinary game drives await — where lions lounge in golden grass and cheetahs race across the plains. Choose between full-day exploration with a gourmet picnic, or return to camp for rest between your adventures. Your final evening here features a candlelit bush dinner — a magical dining experience under the stars, complete with traditional music and the rhythm of Africa in every breath. (B,L,D)
Day 13 Mar 12, Thu	Naivasha's Gentle Waters Travel to Lake Naivasha, where cool waters reflect a sky full of birds. After lunch at your lodge, enjoy a peaceful boat ride and walk among giraffes and gazelles on Crescent Island — no fences, just freedom and grace. (B,L,D)

Day 15 Mar 14, Sat	Iconic Africa, Unfiltered Savour a full day of wildlife discovery with sunrise and sunset safaris. Between drives, relax at camp — a sanctuary of silence and style. As always, nature's symphony plays on. (B,L,D)
Day 16 Mar 15, Sun	Farewell with Music Fly back to Nairobi and enjoy a day at leisure before your final dinner event — a fundraising evening of music and memories with Kai and Catherine, celebrating the magic you've shared. (B,D)
Day 17 Mar 16, Mon	Option 1 – Depart Nairobi Enjoy a leisurely morning, with access to a day room at Crowne Plaza Airport Hotel before your flight home — soul refreshed, spirit uplifted. (B) Option 2 – Beach Extension in Diani Fly to the white sands of Diani for a blissful seaside retreat at Baobab Beach Resort. RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

\$2,000 per person deposit due at time of booking 2nd installment of \$5,000 pp due by August 29, 2025 Balance due by November 28, 2025

Tour documents will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your trip departure, provided full payment has been received.

TOUR PRICES:

All tour prices for land arrangements are based on rates effective at the time of printing and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Should these rates change, it may be necessary to surcharge the price of your vacation. Should the tour price increase by more than 10%, the passenger shall have the right to cancel within seven days of notification without penalty.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:
