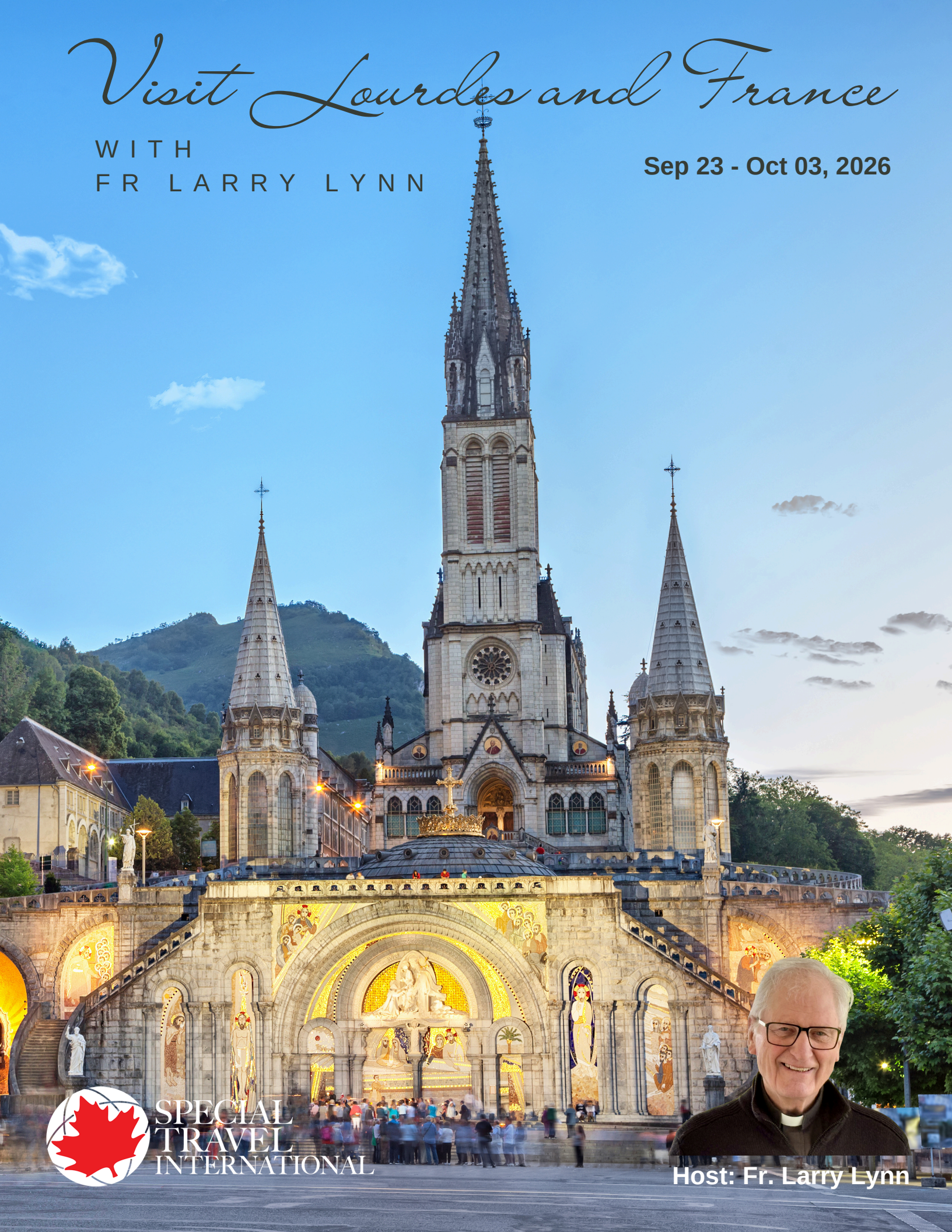

Itinerary

FRANCE PILGRIMAGE
SEP 23 - OCT 3 2026

Day 01 Sep 23, Wed:	Depart Canada Depart for Toulouse
Day 02 Sep 24, Thu:	Arrive Toulouse - Lourdes After arrival Mass and City Tour of Toulouse including the (Couvent des Jacobins) with the Tomb of St. Thomas Aquinas – in the afternoon travel on to Lourdes (D)
Day 03 Sep 25, Fri:	Lourdes Visit Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes, with opportunities to explore the town. (B,D)
Day 04 Sep 26, Sat:	Lourdes All day at the shrine: attend Mass at the Grotto where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858 – bathe in the healing waters and then visit the birthplace of St. Bernadette (family home during the time of the apparitions) – in the afternoon, do the Way of the Cross and attend the blessing of the sick – at night you may join the evening’s rosary and candlelight procession (B,D)
Day 05 Sep 27, Sun:	Lourdes - Bordeaux - Nantes Departure after breakfast and drive to Bordeaux, time for lunch and then city tour with local guide, ending with visit to the Cathedral of Bordeaux (Relics of St. Simon Stock are there), then we continue on, ending the day in Nantes (B,D)
Day 06 Sep 28, Mon:	Nantes - Vannes - Mont St. Michel We travel to the area of Vannes where we visit St. Anne d’Auray (Apparition of St. Anne to Yves) – then across Brittany to famous Mont. St. Michel, where we have time to enjoy the special place including the chapel dedicated to St. Michael (B,D)
Day 07 Sep 29, Tue:	Mont St. Michel - Pontmain - Cancale - Mont St. Michel This morning we travel to nearby Pontmain to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Pontmain – to spend the day in the place of great importance to Pere Maillard, then we visit Cancale, his birth place, before returning to Mont St. Michel area (B,D)
Day 08 Sep 30, Wed:	Mont St. Michel - Landing Beaches - Lisieux Area This morning we travel across Normandy and drive along the landing beaches, visiting Courseulles (Juno Beach where Canadians landed on D-Day) and the nearby cemetery before checking into our hotel in Lisieux Area (B,D)
Day 09 Oct 01, Thu:	Lisieux Area Today we spend in Lisieux, town dedicated to St. Therese, then we travel out to the picturesque village of Honfleur (popular with painters, and also Samuel de Champlain left in 1608 from here for the New World: Canada) (B,D)

Day 10 Oct 02, Fri:	Lisieux Area - Rouen - Paris Travel to Rouen, the historic town, where Jean d'Arc was burnt at the stake – after time there for lunch, we travel on to the Paris area – check in and dinner (B,D)
Day 11 Oct 03, Sat:	Paris Paris to Canada flight home (B)

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

\$800 per person deposit due at time of booking
2nd payment \$1,200 per person by April 24, 2026
Balance due by July 24, 2026

Tour documents will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your trip departure, provided full payment has been received.

TOUR PRICES:

All tour prices for land arrangements are based on rates effective at the time of printing and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Should these rates change, it may be necessary to surcharge the price of your vacation. Should the tour price increase by more than 10%, the passenger shall have the right to cancel within seven days of notification without penalty.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing. The effective cancellation date is the date when written notification is received by Special Travel International (hereafter called STI). Deposits are non-refundable. The following scale of charges will apply per person when cancellation is received prior to departure:

Until April 24, 2026	\$800
From April 24 - July 24, 2026	\$1200
From July 24, 2026	100% non-refundable

NB: different payment/cancellation policies apply to airline tickets; you will be advised at time of booking.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

STI strongly recommends that each tour participant has health, cancellation, interruption, accident and baggage insurance for the duration of his/her travels.



FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY:

STI acts only as an agent in securing all services related to the tours described in this brochure, including transportation, sightseeing and accommodation. STI shall not be responsible or liable for any loss, cost, damage, injury, delay or expense arising from the use of any conveyance, accommodation or service or from acts of God, war, acts of terrorism, strikes, weather, quarantine, accidents, sickness, government regulations, insufficient documents and any loss expense resulting from the above contingencies shall be borne by the tour member. In the event it becomes necessary or advisable for the comfort of the passenger, or for any reason whatsoever, to alter the itinerary or arrangements, such alterations may be made without penalty to the operators. Additional expense, if any, shall be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to withdraw any or all tours should conditions warrant, and also to decline to accept or retain any passenger as a member of the tour. In such instances, full or equitable amounts will be refunded.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, VISAS AND VACCINES:

It is entirely the passenger's responsibility to possess whatever documents, visas and vaccines are required by the law of the countries visited on the tour.

AIRLINE RESPONSIBILITY:

Any air carrier providing transportation in connection with these tours is not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time the passenger is not on board its planes. The passenger contract in use by the airlines concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the purchase of these tours and/or passenger. Similar responsibility as noted applies to all types of carriers, including car rental companies.
