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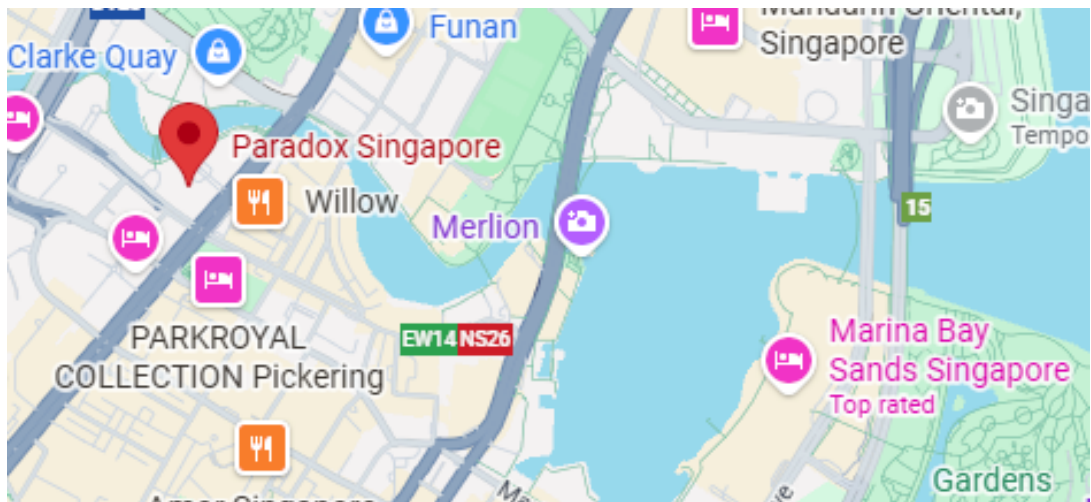

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

- \$4500 per person deposit due at time of booking
- Balance due by Nov 20, 2026
- Tour documents will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your trip departure, provided full payment has been received.

TOUR PRICES:

- All tour prices for land arrangements are based on rates effective at the time of printing and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Should these rates change, it may be necessary to surcharge the price of your vacation. Should the tour price increase by more than 10%, the passenger shall have the right to cancel within seven days of notification without penalty.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

- Notice of cancellation must be made in writing. The effective cancellation date is the date when written notification is received by Special Travel International (hereafter called Special Travel). Deposits are non-refundable. The following dates and non refundable payments will apply per person when cancellation is received prior to departure:
