

COVID-19 Guidelines for Hunters Run Schooling Shows

The following protocols are mandatory at all Hunters Run Stables events due to COVID-19:

- Verification of personal temperature of less than 99.5 degrees before arriving on grounds
- Regardless of temperature, do not attend the Event if feeling ill, showing any signs that could potentially be related to COVID-19, or if you have been in contact with anyone diagnosed or showing symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days of the event.
- Face covering (Mask) must be worn in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of other individuals (who are not members of their immediate household), and when not mounted on a horse. If an individual needs an accommodation due to a verifiable health condition under the Americans with Disabilities Act, please notify the show host at least 24 hours prior to the start of the competition. Attendees will be expected to provide their own masks.
- Hands should be washed and/or sanitized upon arrival at grounds and frequently while in attendance. Attendees should bring a personal supply of hand sanitizer.
- Maintain Social-Distancing of at least 6 feet between non-family members
- Advise the Hunters Run Stables immediately if any person is diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of attending any event.

In addition, to minimize the risk of infection, Hunters Run Stables requests the following:

- Please limit spectators to one per rider.
- Wear your face covering – children and adults – at all times. Masks are not required when riding or mounted as long as you keep your social distance.
- Come dressed to ride. There will not be any areas for changing clothes available.
- Do not congregate in groups on the show grounds.
- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet between non-family members at all times.
- No food will be available at the event, so please bring your own snacks and beverages.

Hunters Run Stables will consistently monitor attendees and participants at the event for rules compliance.
