



2) New Technology / Functionality

New Enterprise Workstation Platform and Graphical User Interface

Our new front-end workstation platform and tools will take you into the next generation of technology, and provide for unmatched flexibility and adaptability. An intelligent, object-oriented user interface, with a Windows™ look and feel, will provide increased user productivity and improved performance. The tools provided with the workstation platform will incorporate knowledge-based features and industry standard visual development tools. And graphical and flexible enterprise reporting and analysis will be available via point and click operation.

Workflow / imaging will support the paperless environment and your business process integration initiatives, along with multimedia integration which will provide for CD-ROM documentation, interactive training and alternative storage methods. This platform will be adapted to all products, with general availability in early 1996.

Scaleable Platforms and Parallel Processing Environments

We will deliver support for the IBM Server 500 System/390 platform and others, giving you a wider range of compatibility and scalability choices for the 21st century. And following in step with IBM on Parallel Technology directions, we will leverage IBM's CMOS technology and its parallel processing environments. CMOS technology is the same air cooled technology architecture (versus water cooled) that is used in the PC and PowerPC(RISC) chip technology. Whether the parallel technology involves vertical structures within one system or is structured on the horizontal design via the Sysplex, we will enable applications to meet your needs. Delivery is scheduled to begin in 1996.

Full Suite of Integrated Applications

Competing in the global market mandates timely access to a wide range of accurate business information. Dun & Bradstreet Software delivers a comprehensive, integrated product line serving customers' financial, human resources, manufacturing and materials management information requirements.
