To the 2025-2026 Dr Walter McAlhaney Scholarship award winners!

The mission of this scholarship is to financially assist a qualified, highly motivated student with **\$3000** college tuition annually (\$1500 per semester), to be paid to the winner's school of choice, toward a degree in higher learning (including bachelor's and master's degrees, trade schools and technical colleges). The student must maintain a B average for the first semester to be granted \$1500 for the second semester. If awarded a scholarship for one year and a 3.0 GPA is maintained, the student will be eligible to receive a scholarship for the next school year. This scholarship is given in memory of Dr. Walter W. McAlhaney, the beloved husband of Wright's House of Hope Board Chair, Kathleen McAlhaney. JUVENILE JUSTICE MINISTRY AT COASTAL EVALUATION CENTER

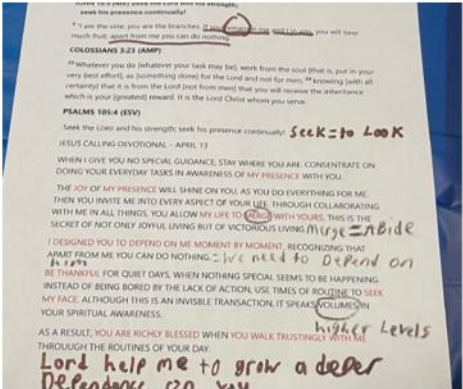
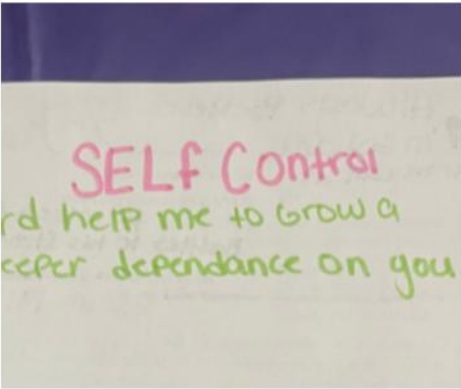
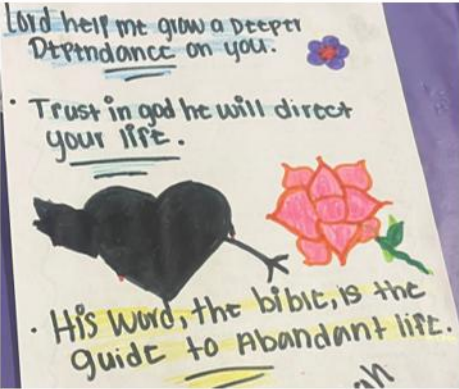
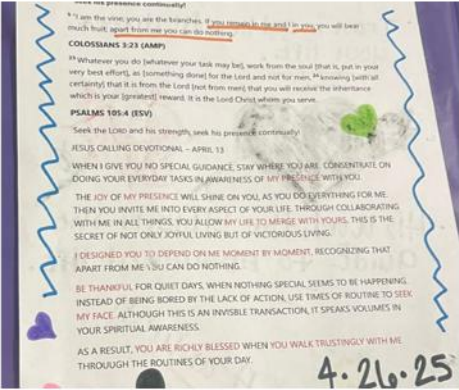
We continue to minister monthly to the young ladies at the Coastal Evaluation Center (CEC), located 30 minutes north of Charleston, SC.
