

24 Challenge Rules:

- ❖ Safety is priority!
- ❖ All riders & pit crew are required to attend the riders meeting at 8am Saturday.
- ❖ All participants and their supporters need to be respectful and have good sportsmanship.
- ❖ Riders must be 14 years of age or older.
- ❖ No pets in the pit area.
- ❖ A working ABC fire extinguisher is required for every pit.
- ❖ There will be limited entries.
- ❖ \$20 gate fee. Children 10 and under are free. Children in pits need to be supervised.
- ❖ All riders are allowed 1 bike per person in the designated pit area.
- ❖ AMA membership is required. All participants are required to pre-register. All participants are required to sign a waiver. Only 1 member will need to pick up the team packet.
- ❖ A transponder will need to be purchased for \$25.00, non-refundable.
- ❖ All bikes must have a minimum 19" front wheel and a 16" rear. No other motorized vehicles such as pit bikes, four wheelers, sxs, golf carts, are allowed on the course, unless it is permitted staff member for workers only.
- ❖ Proper attire is required for all riders. They must wear their helmet, goggles, boots, long pants, gloves, chest protector and a long sleeve shirt.
- ❖ All participants and guests must wear helmets on all bikes.
- ❖ All riders racing must have headlights on their bike, from dusk till day light.
- ❖ Each team or rider will have a pit area. All equipment is required to stay within the designated pit area. Gas cans and generators are the only exception, and they may be kept directly behind the assigned pit area. You are to fit all items within your designated pit area and no sharing pits.
- ❖ Everyone is required to familiarize themselves with where check point and the ambulance station are located. Any medical needs, concerns, please go to one of these destinations for assistance or seek a worker with a reflective vest on. All workers have radios.
- ❖ Accidents happen, bikes break down, please know that you are required to stay with your bike along with your transponder, until staff arranges for the bike to be towed back to the pit area.
- ❖ Riders are not allowed to carry or use radios on the course.
- ❖ Caution: Pit area is part of the track! Do children near track or unsupervised. Be aware of your surroundings.
- ❖ Respect the landowners and staff by removing all items you brought to the pits along with your garbage.
- ❖ Go out there, have fun, and stay safe!
