
IN THE END, WE HOPE YOU LEARN THREE THINGS:








NOW THAT YOU'VE LEARNED ABOUT JESUS OF NAZARETH,






THE HOLY TRINITY

The Holy Trinity is made up of those 3 very distinct parts: The Father (AKA God), The Son (AKA Jesus), and the Holy Spirit (AKA...The Holy Spirit). Think of it like this: you have 3 different pieces of rope. Before you do anything with them, they are just 3 different pieces of rope. But what if you braided them together? Now instead of 3 pieces of rope...they're one single braid. It's not 3 different braids, but 1 braid made up of 3 different ropes.




