



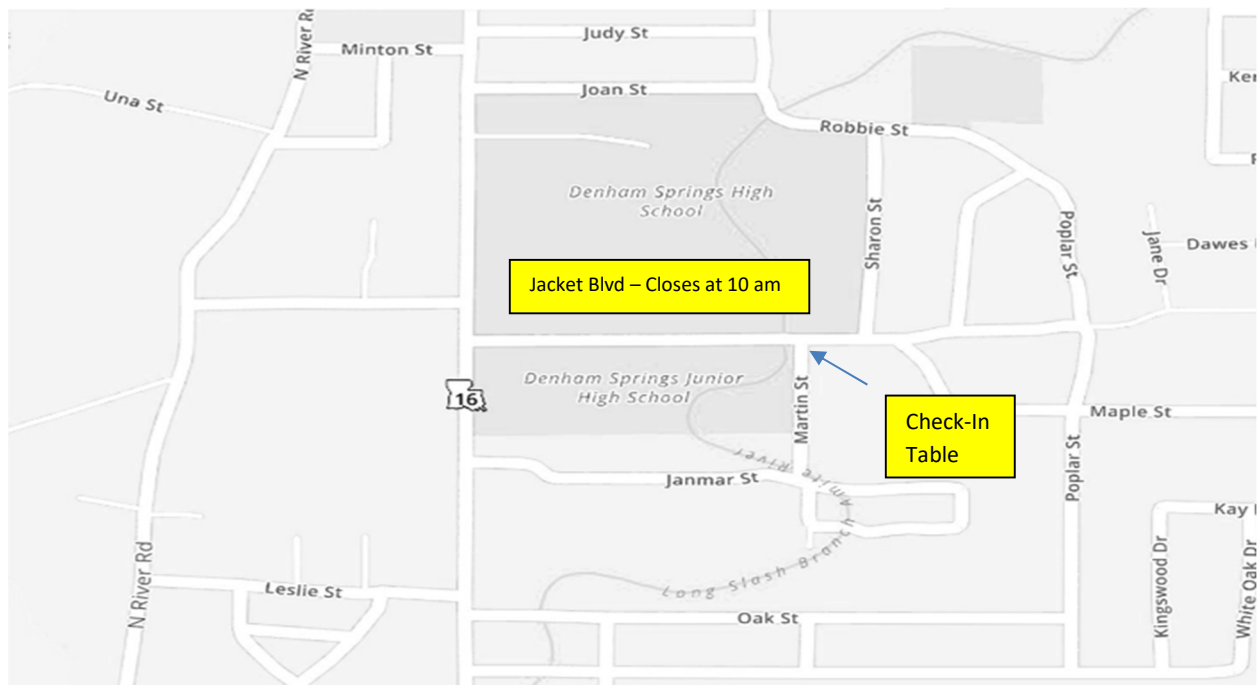

2027 Parade Rules & Information for Non-Krewe Entries Let The Good Times Roar (1920s) – January 23, 2027

1. Check-in and entry to the parade staging area is only allowed from the back side or east side of Yellow Jacket Blvd. – at the intersection of Yellow Jacket Blvd. and Martin St. – **DO NOT attempt to enter from Range Avenue.** All entries must stop at the Check-In Table located in this area. Yellow Jacket Blvd. will be closed at 10:00 am to all thru traffic. **The address of Denham Springs High School is 1000 N. Range Ave, Denham Springs, LA 70726.**
2. **NON-Krewe entries** will be positioned, as directed by the Parade Staff upon check-in, in the Field house parking lot and/or on both sides of Yellow Jacket Blvd. **NO ONE** will be allowed into the parade line-up without this signed form packet. *Please provide a copy of this form packet to the Parade Staff at the check-in point. Mail original to the address indicated at the bottom of the registration form.* **Bands** will assemble in the front lawn of DS High School old gym (dome building).
3. Non-Krewe entries are to report for check-in between 8:30 am and 12:00 pm the day of the parade. Judging will take place at 12:30 pm.
4. If you arrive in vehicles not being used in the parade, you must park in a separate parking area. Parking is available in the student parking lot on the north side of DSHS or behind the school. **DO NOT Park** in the Field House parking lot (by the Football Field) at the back of the parade line up, since this area is reserved for floats and other parade entries. **If it has rained, parking will not be allowed on any grass area.**
5. Once you reach the parade staging area and are checked in, please position your entry as instructed by the parade staff. **Your Pull vehicle and 1 person must stay with your float once you are placed in the lineup area.** Please do not move your parade entry again unless parade staff personnel request you to do so.
6. Restrooms will be open by the DSHS concession stand located between the band room, lunchroom, and new building. We will **NOT** have access to the restrooms in the old gym.
7. Each Float (trailer pulled by a vehicle) must have the required walkers (2 per axle) that must be 16 years of age or older. They must be in place before the parade begins, or you will not be allowed to roll. There is a mandatory drivers and walkers meeting at 1:00pm, on the grass area outside of the previous Freshman High building (in the horseshoe area). **ALL FLOAT WALKERS MUST WEAR BRIGHTLY COLORED SAFETY VESTS. These vests can be purchased at Walmart or any sporting goods store.**
8. All entries in the Parade Contest will be judged based on the following criteria: Best Entry Theme (in line with **parade theme – Let The Good Times Roar (1920s)**), Most Mardi Gras Spirit, and Best Costumes. Winners will be chosen by Parade Judges and announced at the 2:00 pm toasting of the King and Queen at the Royalty float.
9. To ensure the safety of all concerned, consumption of **alcoholic beverages** will **NOT** be allowed in the parade staging area or during the parade. The use of **cell phones** by the driver of the pull vehicle or walkers will **NOT** be allowed while the parade is rolling.

10. Please remember you are on School Property, so **BE RESPECTFUL**. **PLEASE DO NOT LITTER!!** All parade participants are responsible for picking up and disposing of their own garbage. There is limited trash can space. School dumpsters are NOT for our use. No open flames and no firearms are allowed on school grounds.
11. Unless it is storming and lightning, the parade will roll on time at 3:00pm. We won't let a little rain dampen our spirits! If the parade must be canceled due to severe weather, entrance fees are non-refundable.
12. Drivers are NOT to stop and talk to parade spectators. Only one warning will be given by police and then your entry may be escorted out of the parade.
13. Please do not throw anything from your parade entry while on Yellow Jacket Blvd. or in the turn area onto Range Avenue. **This is for safety reasons and as requested by the Denham Springs Police Department.**
14. When turning onto Veterans Boulevard from Range Avenue at the end of the parade, all throwing of items MUST cease. **DO NOT STOP** after turning onto Veterans. Continue on Veterans until you have reached Florida Blvd. – this will allow all the entries following you to exit Range Avenue.
15. **Upon returning to Yellow Jacket Blvd., please continue to the end of the RIGHT-hand side of Yellow Jacket Blvd. (up to Martin St. - near the Football Field), and park close behind each other as directed by the Parade Staff. DO NOT STOP ALONG THE WAY OR DRIVE/PARK ON THE LEFT SIDE OF Yellow Jacket Blvd. We must keep the road open for local traffic at this time since the road is no longer closed.**
16. **Please remember this is a “family oriented” parade. No obscene costumes, gestures, or figures are to be displayed on you or the entry, or thrown during the parade. Music with obscene lyrics is prohibited.**
