


TIMELINE






- DG SANCO (now SANTE), stand alone unit for Seeds (HoU Paivi MANNERKOPI, FI), now Plant Health (HoU Dorothée ANDRE, FR)
- 2007 2008: External Evaluation STUDY, 31.10.2008 (Food consultancy FCEC consortium, incl. Arcadia)
 - Focus on trade facilitation, level-playing field, administrative burden, discrepancies between VCU
 - <u>Biodiversity</u> mentioned 11 times in the 200 pages : only 19% of survey respondents think seed laws have detrimental effect,
 53% positive.
 - Study on Variety Registration, 2010 (FCEC consortium)



- European Commission: Options & Analysis Paper, 2011
 - 5 Scenarios developed : FOCUS ON PROCEDURE
 - Approach to conservation & niche varieties unchanged : through specific provisions in all scenarios except enhanced

flexibility where liberalised (marketed as "non tested varieties" through supplier description)



 - 5 Scenarios developed : <u>FOCUS ON PROCE</u>
 - Approach to conservation & niche varieties flexibility where liberalised (marketed as "r
 - Public Consultation Paper (257 responses)

For the following analysis, stakeholders were divided into categories:

- Competent authorities and ministries: 25% of responses;
- Breeders and PRM suppliers: 30%;
- Users of PRM;
 - non FRM: 13%;
 - Users of PRM emphasizing biodiversity issues: 12%;
- FRM : 15%




Elements from Options 2 & 4 : flexibility for operators – biodiversity

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EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT

- <u>Competence?</u>
 - Not ENVI, but AGRI Committee
 - Rapporteur EPP, Sergio SILVESTRIS, proposed 90 amendments (Draft report 28.10.2013)
 - 12.12.2013 : 841 amendments proposed by COMAGRI MEPs





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
Production and making available on the market of plant reproductive material (plant reproductive material law) ***I

European Parliament legislative resolution of 11 March 2014 on the proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the production and making available on the market of plant reproductive material (plant reproductive material law) (COM(2013)0262 – C7-0121/2013 – 2013/0137(COD))

(Ordinary legislative procedure: first reading)

- 1. Rejects the Commission proposal;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to withdraw its proposal and submit a new one;
- Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.







EUROPEAN COMMISSION

- March 2015 : Formal Withdrawal Proposal





- No more reference to 'commercial exploitation'
- Scope: "production, with a view of making available on the market" &
 "making available on the market" of PRM
- Formal exceptions :
 - solely for testing/scientific purposes,
 - breeding,
 - solely for and maintained by gene banks, organisations and networks of conservation of genetic resources, or persons belonging to these organisations






- Not just listed in an Annex (like today)
- **Formal criteria**: significant area & value of production, number of operators involved, or regulated substances (GM)
- Listed in Annex, with COM delegated powers to amend
- Not just seeds, but also rootstocks & other parts of plants






- Reference to Plant Health Proposal (now Reg 2016/2031)
- Principle of official description based on DUS tests
- For "valuable" species for EU agriculture , *satisfactory VCU*
 - Except for varieties with "officially recognised description"
- For "valuable" species for sustainable development, sustainable VCU
- Testing "under official supervision "









DIFFERENT LEGAL CONTEXT

- UNDROP & right to seeds
- Experience with Conservation/Amateur varieties; Temporary Experiment Cereal Population
- Organic Regulation : OHM notification & Temporary experiment Organic Varieties

DIFFERENT SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONTEXT

- Consolidation Seed Industry (mega-merger)
- Creation / Strengthening Seed Networks & companies
 - COVID crisis : importance of local & resilient food production; nutrition, health

DIFFERENT POLITICAL CONTEXT

- EU Green Deal, Climate objectives, EU Farm to Fork & Biodiversity Strategies
- Commission under pressure from past reform failure
- Conservative but greener European Parliament, with precedent for shared competence AGRI/ENVI (in CAP SP)
 - Conservative Council

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
