
When you travel by car, plane... take this with you to keep the kids busy and practicing English!

- 1. **COLOR** the small images (by making them different colors, competitors won't win at the same time.)
- 2. **LOOK!** When you spot something on your card, say what it is, ex. "There is a blue car!" and cross it off. Try to find everything on your card, or...
- 3. PLAY BINGO! The first to get 4 in a row (up & down, left & right, or diagonal) wins!


