The Templeton Unified School District (TUSD) will hold a school board meeting electronically this evening on ZOOM beginning at 6:00 pm. Members of the public can attend remotely thru ZOOM.

The agenda includes a COVID-19 update by Interim Superintendent Aaron Asplund and reports by school board members – including student board member Blake Fardanesh. (Editor's Note! The agenda also includes a resolution declaring an emergency and granting the District the tools to effectively respond to COVID-19. And under Facilities/Bond there will be a discussion regarding potential projects possible through additional bond funding.

The Templeton Community Services District (TCSD) Facilities Committee will meet on Monday, March 30 at 2:30 pm at the Meadowbrook Wastewater Treatment Plant (1394 Shane Lane).

The Committee will tour the Wastewater Plan with staff and consultants to discuss challenges TCSD is currently facing with regard to complete treatment, steps taken to date to enhance treatment, and immediate

improvements that are recommended, in addition to near and long-term improvements that are currently being evaluated.

The public is invited to attend. The meeting will take place entirely outdoors where social distancing can be maintained. Please wear appropriate clothing and closed toe shoes. The tour will require extensive walking.

Western Groundwater Congress: Depletion of interconnected surface waters: Not that simple
