Honor Flight experiencing cancellations due to virus concerns

The next Honor Flight for Central Coast California is scheduled to take off from San Luis Obispo County Airport on April 20, but several passengers have cancelled their trip due to COVID-19 (coronavirus) concerns.

“Four or five people have cancelled their seats on our April 20th flight,” said Honor Flight CCC Chairman Bear McGill. “Our board has called a special meeting for March 17 to make a decision to either go on the April trip or reschedule.”

According to the latest newsletter from HFCCC, the next flight after April 20th will take off on June 2nd. The group hopes to have one or two flights in the fall but those are yet to be scheduled.

The HFCCC board normally meets the 2nd Monday of the month, but the meeting is being rescheduled to March 17th to make sure that all hands are on deck for this challenging decision. The public is always welcome to attend meetings and participate.

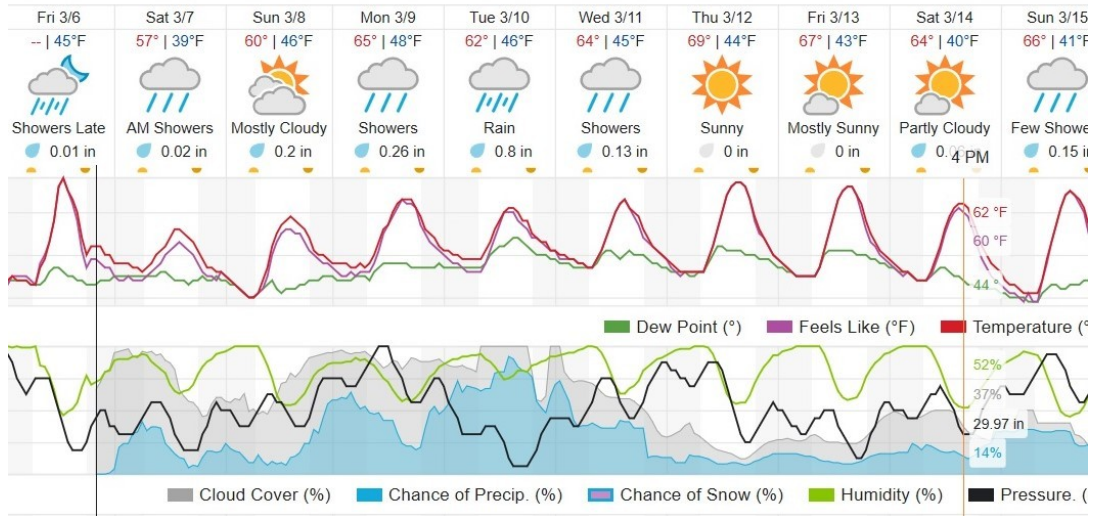
