FROM THE HEART, REV. TOM TURNER

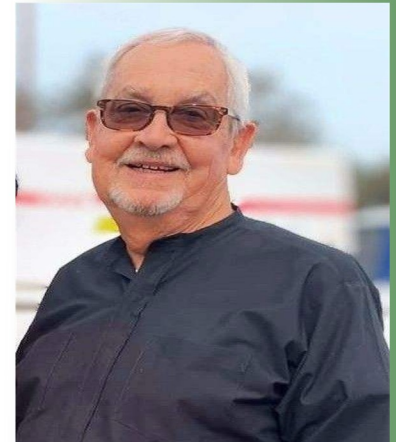
