

November 1st is All Saints Day in which we honor all Saints, know and unknown who now reside with God.


Sunday, November 2nd, we FALL BACK to standard time for our annual Daylight Saving time change.




VESTRY will meet at 5:15pm on Tuesday, October 28th, 2025 and at 5:15pm on Tuesday, November 18th, 2025.



From one Kitchen to Another

Prep Time: 30 mins Cook Time: 3 hrs

Servings: 8



Directions

- 1. Gather all ingredients.
- 2. Place chicken, tomatoes, enchilada sauce, green chiles, onion, and garlic into a slow cooker.

Ingredients

- 1 pound shredded, cooked chicken
- 1 (15 ounce) can whole peeled tomatoes, mashed
- 1 (10 ounce) can enchilada sauce
- 1 (4 ounce) can chopped green chile peppers
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 cups water
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can chicken broth
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon black pepper
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 (10 ounce) package frozen corn
- 1 tablespoon chopped cilantro
- 7 corn tortillas

2 tablespoons vegetable oil, or as needed

- 3. Pour in water and chicken broth; season with cumin, chili powder, salt, pepper, and bay leaf. Stir in corn and cilantro. Cover and cook on Low for 6 to 8 hours or on High for 3 to 4 hours.
- 4. When the soup is almost finished, preheat the oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C). Lightly brush both sides of tortillas with oil.
- 5. Cut tortillas into strips, then spread on a baking sheet.
- 6. Bake in the preheated oven until crisp, 10 to 15 minutes. Sprinkle tortilla strips over soup before serving. Garnish as desired.

NOTE:

Instead of step 4, 5 & 6, I buy pre made/packaged corn tortilla strips





























