# DID YOU? KNOW: Pet Owner Rules

This is the most obvious rule, but sometimes it gets forgotten. **Don't forget your poop bags, or to pick up after your dog**. Only one dog per homeowner, with an adult weight of no more than 25lbs, is permitted at BV2. Renters are not allowed to have dogs at BV2.

## **Bulk Items Rules**

Placing garbage on the curb in kitchen trash bags or disposable grocery store bags is unacceptable and will subject you to fines of \$25.00 per occurrence. Bulk waste includes only household **oversized items** such as furniture, mattresses, appliances, and other bulky nonhazardous household items. Bulk items are to be put out at bulk area on **Wednesday only,** for Thursday pick up.

## **Crime Prevention Tips**

- 3. Cover windows with curtains or blinds to maintain privacy.
- 4. Always lock your front door and sliding doors.
