



Scavenger Hunt

Teacher Overview

- Your students should arrive at the exhibit with their scavenger hunt pages, pencils and clipboards. (We can supply clipboards if necessary)
- Upon their arrival, we will lead the students single file through the exhibit to familiarize them with the layout. They should **not** try to work on their scavenger hunt pages during that initial walkthrough.
- When they get to the end of the exhibit, our staff will have them sit in rows on the gym floor. Once everyone is seated, we will go over their scavenger hunts, giving them instructions on how to read the signage and where to find the answers.
- Once they have been given their instructions, we allow them to work in pairs, groups or independently to complete their scavenger hunt pages.
- Although it is encouraged, we realize that teachers may not be able to be in the gym with their students. If you can insure that they have their scavenger hunt pages when they arrive at the gym, we can take care of everything after that.

* **Kinder Teachers** - Your scavenger hunts are visual and do not require reading skills to complete. Your students will simply look for images on our signs that match with the images on their scavenger hunt pages and then put a check mark in the box when they find it. You'll notice the word "Blue, Yellow or Green" next to the check boxes. Our signs are color coded and this will help the students know what color sign to look for.
