3) What weighed more; Megalodon the shark or T-rex? \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Green Sign/Yellow Sign – 1 ton = 2000 pounds

4) Find the aquatic creature with three pairs of jaws \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Green Sign – Not a shark – Jurassic World – Sea - Texas

5) What is a Coprolite? \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Green Sign – Duckbills – Something smells about this – Winnie’s last name – Herbivore

6) Find the 450 million year old “STAR” \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Blue Sign – We see them in the sky at night – Best friend of a talking sponge - Omnivore

7) Find the animal whose name means “Lizard Tooth”. \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Green Sign – Fins – Sword – Carnivore - Sea

8) Find the fastest mammal in the museum \_\_\_\_\_

Hints: Yellow Sign – Opposite of Dog – Doesn’t Play Fair – Spotted - King
