Scusset Beach State Park 2021 Rules and Regulations

Specific to this facility:

Fires in community fire pit only. There are no campfires permitted on RV sites. Fires must be extinguished by midnight.

Only propane for cooking, no charcoal.

The dumping station hours are 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Please read the important information below.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Massachusetts State Parks and Campgrounds.

Massachusetts prohibits the transportation of firewood into or out of any DCR campground. Firewood must be purchased at the campground. Transportation of firewood or other wood products may result in eviction.

Check-in time is 1:00 to 9:00 pm; check out by 11:00 am. Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. The use of generators is permitted during quiet hours for medical purposes only. You must inform the wagonmaster of your need for quiet time generator use with your reservation.

Camping with Pets:

Pets are permitted and there is a limit of four pets per campsite. A current rabies certificate must be presented at check-in. Pets must be leashed at all times and cannot be left unattended.
