### NAFCA NATIONAL ELECTIONS

All National positions are open for election. A slate of candidates will be presented at the Council of Chapters meeting in October. Elections will be held in January for a two-year term starting April 1, 2022.

Board of Directors meetings are held four times annually following the close of each fiscal quarter. January, April, July/August, October. The April meeting is usually held the same day as the Annual Meeting and the October meeting is held the same day as the Council of Chapters meeting. There is also a Council of Chapters meeting at Spring Safari.

If interested in any of the Board positions, please inform your State Director or any NAFCA officer listed in the Chatter.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

To be eligible for these offices, candidates must have served as a state or chapter elected officer.

### RESPONSIBILITIES OF NAFCA OFFICERS

**PRESIDENT:** To preside at NAFCA Board and Executive Committee meetings, to appoint standing and special committees, to present an annual budget and to perform such other duties as pertain to the office.

**VICE PRESIDENT:** To familiarize themselves with the duties of the president.

To preside at NAFCA Board of Director meetings in the absence of the president.

The 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents must be prepared to assist and support the president in the performance of duties at all times and to perform the duties of the president in the absence of the president.

**SECRETARY:** To keep accurate, written records of all NAFCA Board and Executive Committee meetings and distribute these reports to members of these bodies.

To perform the duties of clerk in recording and documenting votes of the Board of Directors as they pertain to written contracts and/or agreements of the association.

**TREASURER:** Keep accurate written records of all monies and make all authorized disbursements.

Distribute quarterly financial reports to the NAFCA Board of Directors. To annually publish in the official publication of NAFCA, notice on annual billing for dues, that an annual financial report of the Corporation is available to all members upon request.

In addition to the above responsibilities, officers will address situations as they arise, and take on other assignments as necessary.

Hi and greetings from your NAFCaree committee. Have you set aside the dates? The dates are firm and you can rest assured the committee has put together a week of family fun in Canada for all to enjoy. The committee should have all that information and a reservation form, out by the end of September or Council of Chapters Weekend (October 1-3) at Canoe River Campground in Mansfield, MA.

Please remember you will need a passport or passport card to cross into Canada from the USA. A new passport application can take up to six months to process, so, if you need to get your passport for NAFCaree, keep that in mind.

We have asked the campground for seventy sites total and half of the sites (35) will have water and electric hookups and the other half (35 sites) will have water, electric and sewer hookups.

The campground offers a nice swimming beach along the river and swimming pool with a life guard. There are boats to rent. You may want to go fishing in the river. Fishing, I've been told, is very good in this river. There are walking trails right from the campground. There is an lounge with a t.v, and a game room for anyone to use. The camp store has some basic needs items and downtown Kingston is only a short drive from Rideau with plenty of stores to shop in.
