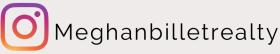

## Real Estate Terms

### **Earnest Money**

The title company holds money until the sale is legally finalized. If deadlines are met and transaction is terminated, this money can be returned.



### **Appraisal**

The lender sends out an appraiser to gather a professional opinion on if the value of the house is the amount the buyer is seeking.



### Inspection

The buyer pays for a professional inspector to inspect the home and create a report on any issues with the home. The buyer can then work with the agent to decide any action needed.

### Equity

The current market value of your home minus what you owe. Instant equity is when the appraisal comes back over sale price.





## Important Information

### Showing Etiquette

When it comes time to attend showings and open houses a couple rules of thumb:

- Arrive on time, if running behind please send me a quick text message.
- Sometimes plans need to change and I am happy to work with you, please let me know as soon as possible so we can reschedule the showing.
- Please use the restroom before coming to the showing.
- Please keep your children close to you when walking through the home.

### Open Houses and New Builds

Open houses are a great opportunity to see a home. A hosting agent will be present to welcome you and answer any questions you may have about the property. Please inform them that you are working with me and let me know if you are interested in moving forward with the home.

### Zillow and Realtor.com

Foreclosures and Pre-Foreclosures often show up on these online platforms. Often times if a house shows up in pre-forclosure, it is not entirely true. This could mean that only one or two payments were missed.

A house in foreclosure can increase your closing costs and repairs and can be more out of your pocket than a home not in foreclosure.



# Mortgage Mistakes

Do not quit or change your job or become selfemployed during the

Do not purchase any new vehicles

Do not open up any new credit (unless advised by your lender)

Do not get behind on your bills

Do not change bank accounts or co-sign a loan for anyone

Do not make any unusually large deposits into your bank account outside of your paycheck.

Do not make any big credit card purchases and pay off the full balance every statement.

Do not buy new furniture before closing (even if using a credit card)

Be sure to check with your lender prior to using any large amount of cash or taking cash from family prior to closing
