RESOLUTION NO. 16-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAZY LAKE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF 4.7931 FOR THE VILLAGE'S GENERAL OPERATING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a final budget has been prepared estimating expenditure and revenues of the Village for the ensuing year, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad valorem levy, and recommendations have been made as to the amount to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Lazy Lake has conducted a public hearing and has considered recommendations, the suggested final budget, and the proposed millage to be levied to carry on the government of the Village for the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAZY LAKE, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The final millage rate necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the Village of Lazy Lake, Florida, to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the final budget for the fiscal year is hereby set at 4.7931 mills.

Section 3. The final millage adopted herein is greater than the rolled-back rate computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, 2010, as amended) by 7.51 %.

Section 4. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be construed as eliminated and shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

1 **Section 5.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are

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4 **Section 6.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
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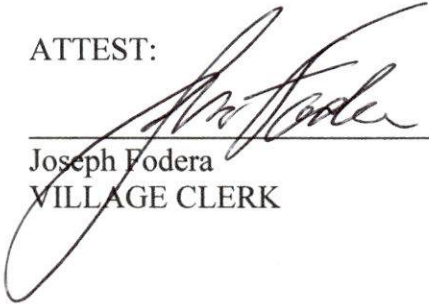
