Sgt Chadwick has completed 13 years of exemplary service within the British Armed Forces. He enlisted into the Army in 2007 and joined the Parachute Regiment, deploying on multiple Operations and Overseas Exercises in Europe, the Middle East, Africa and South America. After a spell with the Special Forces Support Group, Sgt Chadwick became the lead Parachute Regiment Physical Training Instructor at the Infantry Training Centre where he went on to gain a BSc (hons) in Sport, Fitness and Coaching. Sgt Chadwick was then selected for and successfully transferred into the Royal Army Physical Training Corps (RAPTC) in 2017, winning multiple awards during his Class 1 Instructors course.

Sgt Chadwick's first assignment with the RAPTC was at 7th Infantry Brigade. During this assignment, he began to acknowledge the need for individualising training for soldiers and through extensive research, began creating frameworks which are now used as best practice across the Army. Sgt Chadwick was awarded a Brigadiers Commendation for the planning and execution of various high profile projects, along with being selected to form a small team which would coordinate and deliver training and best practice to the rest of the British Army. Sgt Chadwick was influential in ensuring that various physical development projects were planned, risk evasive, delivered to the expected outcomes and benefits, on time and under budget.

In 2018, Sgt Chadwick was assigned to the Army Foundation College (AFC) in Harrogate as a syndicate leader and project manager whereby he undertook many successful projects. Most notably, he was responsible for the design and delivery of the Common Military Syllabus and OP ACHILLES; a physical development pathway which more than doubled the pass rate and in doing so improved operational capability for the Army's spearhead units. These projects involved the requirement to measure progress objectively, motivate multi-disciplinary teams, manage risk, meet strict timelines and facilitate the procurement of equipment within a budget. Consequently, as a result of his tireless work, the AFC is now in a position to optimise human performance and reduce wastage through the minimising of muscular-skeletal injuries. Sgt Chadwick also orchestrated various high-profile visits and sporting competitions including one of the military's most prestigious and largest inter-company boxing competitions.

More recently, Sgt Chadwick has been employed as the AFC Sports Co-Coordinator. This job role involved the requirement for him to provide assurance to the Army for the Publicly Funded Initiative (PFI) Contract, as well as coordinating the many sports delivered to the college. Moreover, Sgt Chadwick has also supported the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme by successfully managing the Sports and Skills sessions and communicating progress reports to various stakeholders, in order that the Junior Soldiers are given a world class experience which will amplify their military career.

Throughout his career and working predominantly at and above management level, Sgt Chadwick has excelled in every area. This is evident in the various commendations he has been awarded, including a GOCs commendation which was announced alongside The Queens Birthday Honours list 2019 and the Bredin Trophy for the soldier who has contributed most to enhance the prestige of the Army. Additionally, Sgt Chadwick was awarded a Colonel Commandants Commendation from the Parachute Regiment, the RAPTC Corps Sergeant Majors Commendation and the offer of Commission. Sgt Chadwick will be sorely missed by the British Army. He is the absolute exemplar of a Soldier and he is commended on an extremely impressive career. There is no doubt that this extremely motivated and professional individual will prove successful to any business or agency lucky enough to receive his application or interest.
