**PHYSICAL:** A solid, compact build with a smaller frame that reminds me a lot of Cedric Mullins. An agile runner and built upper body. Seems very athletic and is capable of being an above average runner with the speed he possesses both around the bases and in the outfield.

**STRENGTHS:** Shows patience in the box and can work the count. Solid bat speed accompanied by gap-to-gap power. His above average run grade bodes well for extra base hits at his current and future levels. Seems comfortable in an open stance and small leg kick when loading up. Able to hustle out close plays in the infield at 1B and always looks active in the basepaths. High IQ athlete capable of playing the outfield regularly due to his range and instincts defensively. Decisive speed allows him to cover ground and take good routes with decent lateral agility.

**WEAKNESSES:** Has yet to translate his speed into stolen bases. Lots of hand movement in his stance and drops bat head out in front prior to loading up. Seems to use a lot more of his upper body and sometimes dismisses his lower half which lessens power potential. Below-average arm strength which limits him to LF and CF.

**SUMMARY:** Would like to see Hannah use his lower half more effectively to tap into his overall power. His plus speed times and capable defensive IQ projects him into being an outfielder at the Major League level but may not be an everyday regular. On the offensive side of the ball he's able to reach base and draw walks. Reaching double digit home runs could be possible in the bigs if he tweaks and refines his hitting mechanics to be a little less loud at the dish. Above average runner with plus speed; which could allow him to swipe some more bases as he progresses.
