PHYSICAL: Solid frame with an athletic build. Fits the muscular mold and has great size for a catcher. Somewhat maxed out in terms of size but in great shape with a strong lower half.

STRENGTHS: Comfortable behind home plate; swift and has great awareness with runners on. Athletic in crouch, average pop times and receiving skills have improved over the years.
