STORM SEASON TIPS

Below are some helpful preparedness tips all residents should keep in mind this hurricane season:

- Have an evacuation plan: Where will you go and how will you get there?
- Designate a small, interior, windowless room in the house to shelter yourself in case of emergency
- Gather emergency supplies: food, water, medicine, flashlights, batteries, etc.

- To prepare for flooding, stockpile sandbags and clean out drains, gutters, and downspouts
