

COLOR RUN RULES FOR PARTICIPATANTS

\$30 ADULTS

\$20 STUDENTS 17 AND UNDER

This 5k fundraising run for the North Port High Visual & Performing Arts Programs is aiming to provide a fun and exciting race experience for the whole family.

Your entry fee covers your race, Color Run T-Shirt, & Race Medallion! Make sure to complete registration by January 31, 2023 to secure your T-Shirt & Medallion! You will not be eligible to receive a T-Shirt & Medallion if you are register after January 31st.

Here's what you can look forward to in our Color Run:

Expect to be covered head-to-toe in safe Color Powder (made from food-grade dye and corn starch!) Wear your Color-Run T-Shirt, or any white T-Shirt to help the colors be more vibrant!

You don't have to run to have fun! As long as you stay with the rule "walkers to the left, runners to the right", everyone will have a great time!

There will be several Color Zone Stations throughout the run! Each color station will use a different color of dry powder, which will be sprayed onto runners from large bottles. If you want to be covered in color, make sure to give yourself plenty of time getting through each color zone!

Our color powder will stick to just about everything! To be safe wear a pair of protective glasses or sunglasses, and keep your phone protected! A cheap ziplock/waterproof bag will do the trick. It also will wash off your skin and hair fairly easily.

The color powder is made from food-grade dye and corn starch and is 100% non-toxic, however if you have any breathing difficulty (asthma, allergies, or any other concern) bring a bandana/face mask to wear when running through Color Zones so you don't breathe in our color powder!

After you finish your race, there's no need to rush home! The after-party will include food trucks, complimentary water, music, and Arts Festival.

Make sure to bring something to protect the interior of your car when leaving - as we want to keep the color powder from staining your seats!

In the end, the Color Run is about having fun, and supporting The North Port High Visual & Performing Arts Programs.
